Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements, and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting, and or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

## Directions

1. Sew one CX5473 1" x $101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece to the top and bottom of each CX5474 $101 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 103 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ piece. Sew one CX5473 31" x $113 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ piece to each side.
2. Sew one CX5477 $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 111 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece to the top and bottom of each square. Sew one CX5477 $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 133 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ piece to each side.
3. For the cornerstones machine applique (1) CM0376 1" square to the center of each DC5153 2 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Make (9) total.
4. For the sashing rows, begin and end with one DC5153 $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square and alternate with (2) CX5475 2 1/2" x 13 3/4" pieces. Make (3) total. Set aside.
5. Beginning and ending with a CX5475 $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 131 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece alternate with two blocks. Make (2) rows. Keep motifs upright in vertical rows.
6. Sew the rows together begin with a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sashing strip. Alternate with the two vertical block rows. End with a sashing strip to make one $321 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 33^{\prime \prime}$ piece as shown.
7. Sew one CM0376 $1^{\prime \prime} \times 321 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece to the top and bottom of the quilt. Sew one CM0376 $1^{\prime \prime} \times$ $33^{\prime \prime}$ piece to each side.
8. Sew one CX5475 $103 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 331 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece to the top and bottom of the quilt. The print edge should be the outside edge of the quilt.
9. Sew one CM5474 8" $\times 103 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to the top and bottom of each CX5475 $8^{\prime \prime} \times 34^{\prime \prime}$ strip. Keep motifs upright. Make 2. Sew one to each side of the quilt as shown.
10. Layer backing, batting, and quilt top. Baste.
11. Quilt as desired.
12. Bind quilt using K2149 $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips pieced as needed for length.
