Technical Tips

When threading your machine, be sure your presser foot is in the UP position. This allows the thread to be properly seated in the tension disks. At this point you should be able to pull the thread freely.

When you are ready to thread your needle, lower the presser foot. There should now be tension on the thread and it should not pull. If it pulls easily at this stage, **START AGAIN** because you do not have it in the tension disks.

great approach to life and creativity keeps those who know her coming back for more.

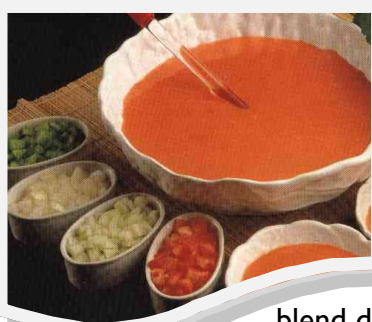

Recipe Roundup

Gazpacho—Cool Summer Soup

There are as many variations of gazpacho as there are cooks. This is my quick version. This recipe serves 6, and can be doubled/tripled, etc. without problem. This version should be made at least 24 hours prior to use and served well chilled.



Ingredients:

- One 14 oz can V8 juice
- One 14 oz can stewed tomatoes w/garlic & peppers
- One 12 oz can beef consommé

Place all ingredients in blender and blend thoroughly. You can also use an immersion stick blender and

blend directly in a pitcher. The mixture will froth and must rest overnight. Skim and discard any froth prior to serving. Taste and adjust seasoning. I sometimes like to add a dash of Worcestershire sauce. Chop a variety of fresh vegetables to serve with the soup:

Vidalia Onions, Summer Squash, Avocados, Zucchini, Cucumbers, Red and Green Peppers, Celery, Chopped Green Olives, Tomatoes.

Choose your favorites and serve them in small separate bowls so that each person can add the variety of their choice.

And it is even healthy!

This soup will keep for up to a week in the refrigerator and makes a quick elegant addition to any dinner or luncheon.

Did you know??

- That although Isaac Singer invented the straight stitch sewing machine, it was a woman, Helen Augusta Blanchard, who invented the zigzag sewing machine. Her "overseaming" machine can be seen in the Smithsonian.
