Shirley's Recipe Corner

Now that Spring and Summer are right around the corner, I thought these recipes would fit the seasons.

Peach Raspberry Crisp

10-12 large firm, ripe peaches
1 orange, zested
1 1/4 cups granulated sugar
1 cup light brown sugar
1 1/2 cups plus 2 to 3 tablespoons flour
1/2 pint raspberries
1/4 teaspoon salt
1 cup quick-cooking oatmeal
1/2 pound cold unsalted butter,

diced

Preheat the oven to 350 degrees. Butter the inside of a 10" by 15" by 2 1/2" oval baking dish. Peel the peaches and slice them into thick wedges and place them in a large bowl. Add the orange zest, 1/4 cup granulated sugar, 1/2 cup brown sugar, and 2 T. Flour. Toss well.

Gently mix in the raspberries.

Allow the mixture to sit for 5 minutes. If there is a lot of liquid, add 1 more T. Flour. Pour the peaches into the baking dish and gently smooth the top.

Combine 1 1/2 cups flour, 1 cup sugar, 1/2 cup brown sugar, salt, oatmeal, and the cold, diced butter. Mix on low speed with an electric mixer until the butter is pea-sized and the mixture is crumbly. Sprinkle evenly on top of the peaches and raspberries. Bake for 1 hour, until the top is browned and crisp and the juices are bubbly. Serve warm.

Salmon Ball

1 lb. Can salmon 1 8 oz. Cream cheese 1 T. Lemon juice 2 t. Onion, grated 1 T. Horseradish 1/4 t. Salt

1/4 t. Liquid smoke 1/2 c. Pecans, chopped 3 T. Parsley, chopped

Drain and flake salmon. Combine everything except parsley and pecans. Form into ball.

Roll ball in parsley and pecans.

NG SCHEDU

SKILL LEVEL I

Some sewing experience will be helpful. Basic use of your sewing machine may be required. Some Skill Level I classes are true beginner's classes and you start from the very beginning.

SKILL LEVEL II

These are not basic sewing classes, so you will need a background...perhaps the basic classes or experience in other areas of sewing. When machines are required, you should be well familiar with the functions of your specific model of machine.


