**New Pattern info:** The fall collection is comprised of three new patterns. The first is a great new dress called the Madeline Maxi Dress. It is offered in two lengths, knee and ankle. It has a sleeveless bodice, V-neckline, wide raised waistband, and full skirt with options for a pieced or ruffled hem. The next design is a wonderful new jacket called the Savannah Swing Jacket. It features a collared, yoked bodice with a gentle A-line to a cropped or fingertip length with two different pleated options. The set-in style sleeves are bracelet length with many cuff options. This jacket can be fully lined with instructions included for an unlined version as well. The last design is a follow-

up to the popular Fashion Formula Skirts booklet released last fall. Fashion Formula Skirts 2 features 4 new skirt designs based on the same notion of cutting the pieces based on hip measurement with no pattern pieces required!

# SHIRLEY'S RECIPE CORNER

The first recipe is for Lemon Cookies. We served them at a tea and we had several requests for the recipe. The second recipe is for Hamburger-Vegetable soup in the hopes that the hot summer will end and cool days will come when a soup will sound good.

## High Tea Lemon Cookies

2 cups butter, room temperature  
2/3 cup powdered sugar  
1 tsp. grated lemon zest  
1/2 tsp. Vanilla  
2 cups flour  
1 1/2 cups cornstarch (Yes, that's right 1 1/2 CUPS)

Heat oven to 350 degrees. In a large bowl, beat butter until creamy. Add powdered sugar; mix until light and fluffy. Add lemon zest and vanilla. Beat well. Add flour and cornstarch into butter mixture until well combined. Note: At first the dough will look dry -- but don't worry, the dough slowly comes together as you mix it and the butter melts into the dry ingredients.

*Do not refrigerate this dough as the butter will harden and make the dough unmanageable for rolling into a ball.*

Using your hands, roll cookie dough into 1 inch balls. Place onto ungreased cookie sheets and bake 15 minutes or until bottoms are light brown. Remove from oven, carefully remove from baking sheets, and cool on cooling racks.

When cookies have cooled, spread Lemon Frosting onto top of cookie.

Yield: 6 dozen cookies

## Lemon Frosting

*This recipe makes enough for a double batch of cookies*

1/3 cup butter, room temperature  
1 tsp. Grated lemon zest  
1/3 to 1/2 cup freshly-squeezed lemon juice  
4 cups powdered sugar

In medium bowl, combine butter, lemon zest, lemon juice, and powdered sugar; stir until well mixed. Note: Additional lemon juice may be needed to get the frosting thin enough.

## Hamburger-Vegetable Soup

1 lb ground beef  
1 cup onion - chopped  
1 cup potatoes - chopped  
1 cup carrots - chopped  
1 cup cabbage - shredded  
1 cup celery - sliced  
4 cups tomatoes  
1/4 cup rice  
3 cups water  
4 tsp. Salt  
1/4 tsp. Basil  
1/4 tsp. Thyme  
1 bay leaf

Cook the onion and ground beef together until the beef is lightly browned. Drain off excess fat and add all the remaining ingredients. Bring the mixture to a boil and cover. Simmer for 1 hour. Makes 9 cups.

# CURRENT SEWING SCHEDULE



Many classes have kits that are required and we have tried to keep their expense to a minimum. Many classes do not require a kit, but do require supplies. We ask that you purchase the class supplies from the Berry Patch. This is the only way we can maintain low class fees.

Our classes are presented for the individual use of those attending. If you teach somewhere else or plan to do so, please let us know. We have different class fees when we train teachers.

Most classes fill quickly, so we suggest you register early to reserve your spot!

## SKILL LEVEL I

Some sewing experience will be helpful. Basic use of your sewing machine may be required. Some Skill Level I classes are true beginner's classes and you start from the very beginning.

## SKILL LEVEL II

These are not basic sewing classes, so you will need a background...perhaps the basic classes or experience in other areas of sewing. When machines are required, you should be well familiar with the functions of your specific model of machine.

# CURRENT SEWING SCHEDULE



We believe that our class schedule is an important part of the service we provide. Our teachers and staff work hard to provide quality training in many areas and we appreciate your participation.

In the future, we will make three the minimum number of students for a class to be held. We ask that you sign up for the classes you wish to take as soon as you decide, rather than wait to see if the class makes with the minimum three students.

This will help us with scheduling.

We also request that you purchase the supplies necessary for the class from us. This is the only way we can maintain our low class fees. If the minimum three students is not met, we will refund your class fee. We suggest you purchase any specialized supplies after the class has made. We can call you to let you know before the class date.

Finally, we ask that you call us if you have signed up and paid for a class, but do not intend to attend. If you call us three days before the class date, we will be happy to refund your fee.
