SPEED LIMIT CHANGE

In November of 2009, the Village Board passed an ordinance to **lower the Village speed limit to 25 mph** (Chapter 8, Article IV, Section 4). Implementation would happen as signs were replaced due to Federal MUTCD code changes. We are now ready to start replacing these signs. We will start on the West side of town in Mallard Point, at the suggestion of our Police Chief, and work our way back across town. The signs will be marked with red flags, for several weeks, to draw attention to this change.

Sewer update: Televising of Mallard Point Subdivision is all that remains prior to allowing homeowners to begin hooking on to the Sewer System. Due to the heavy equipment that is required to do the remaining televising, the ground must freeze before it can be completed.

Dear Residents,

Your Village Board is pleased to announce that the completion of the ten year sewer system project is closer than ever to being ready for usage. We are currently waiting for the sewer pipes in Mallard Subdivision to be visually inspected for structural integrity and functionality. The sewer inspection contractors need the ground to be frozen so they do not damage lawns from their heavy equipment. Unfortunately, our mild winter has caused this unexpected delay. The contractors only need a week to complete the inspection and they were scheduled to be in town on 2/13/12. We are happy to see this day arrive and see this multi-year and multi-million dollar project come to fruition. We made it through construction the last few years, and we are confident we can make it through this final phase.

Once these pipes are inspected and passed by Farnsworth, the sewer connection letters will be sent to every homeowner and business owner in the Village. This letter contains the step by step procedures to follow in order to get your home connected to the sewer system. **PLEASE review this letter carefully**.

At our February Board meeting, the Board also approved the hiring of a candidate for the Public Works Superintendent position. This new hire's first order of business will be devoted to water plant operations and water system delivery. This candidate has an Illinois Class A water operator's license, which is the highest attainable accreditation for water systems. We look forward to this position bringing the Village the expertise and experience needed to improve our water quality, monitor our new sewer system, and be more cost-effective.

Please join me in welcoming our new Public Works Superintendent to town. I look forward to more progress to come as our Village makes a huge step forward in our infrastructure with this position.

Street Report For February 2012

The groundhog says 6 more weeks of winter, but hopefully it is 6 more weeks of the winter we have experienced so far. As I write this a new storom is approaching another predicted for the middle of the week. Somehow I don't feel we will keep skirting old-man winter for the 6 more weeks, but I hope I am wrong.

The purchase of the new tractor is progressing slowere than I had hoped, but I found out they are not yet making our horse power version of the tractor. We are requesting a demo model to assure it will met our needs anyway so the delay is good. We hope to have the tractor by this fall unless we need to go a different direction.

The nice weather has allowed us to continue with sign replacement. Again, all weight limit signs have been posted and if you are a business that operates above these limits on the our streets you must apply for a permit or risk being pulled over for exceeding posted limits. This permit application can be gotten from the Village website or Village Hall and returned to the Village Hall to my attention. The Village has a posted 9 ton (16k pounds) weight limit year round.

Also, we will be changing the speed limit signs over the next month on the west side of town, at the request/suggestion of our police chief. Every street West of Seminary Street will be under this new speed limit of 25 mph. This reduction is per ordinance Chapter 8 Article IV Section 4. Initial speed limit signs will have red flags on them to help draw attention to these changes.


Dear Villages,

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
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
