NOTIONS/EQUIPMENT:

Fabric scraps for practice if you like
Thread to match the motifs, not the background
Appliqué needle; I use a #11 straw/milliner's needle. Some people prefer a sharp.
Thimble
Scissors for fabric, and scissors for Mylar and paper.
Pencil; mechanical pencil works the best.
Fabric marking pencils, one light and one dark (the mechanical pencil will work for dark and white mechanical pencils are great, too).
Appliqué pins
Clover mini-iron
Small ironing surface
Wooden toothpick
Piece of fine sandpaper, about 8 1/2" x 11"
No-melt, or heat resistant, Mylar.
Fine permanent black pen; I love the Identipen.
Spray starch, sizing, or Best Press
Small paintbrush or Q-tip

Optional:

Stilletto
1/4" bias tape maker - my favorite way to make stems
If you have a light box, it is very useful.
Karen Kay Buckley's Perfect Circles tool is wonderful
Freezer paper if you have it.
