

Class Supply List

Class: (Not So) Heavy Metal –Embellishments 6

Instructor: Carol Wight Jones

Description of Class: In this class you will be able to experiment with various metal items with which you can embellish your quilts. You will make several samples, but you can also make a small quilt if you like.

Kit fee of \$15.00 to be paid directly to instructor. This will include various metal objects.

Fabric Requirements:

- Bring several pieces of fabric to use as a base for your metal embellishments.
- You may want to start with 10 or 12 inch squares.
- Batting or timentex pieces about the size of your fabric pieces.
- If you want to make a small quilt, bring suitable fabric, batting, and backing slightly larger than your desired finished size.
- Piece of fabric for binding, as long as desired finished length of quilt by 6 inches wide.

Tools and Notions Required:

- Basic Sewing supplies
- Sewing Machine in good working order, power cord, foot pedal
- Size 80 and 90 topstitch needles
- Glue stick
- Various threads - you may want to include some metallic thread. You will be stitching on light metal and couching some wire elements.
- Utility scissors – something you can cut paper or tape with
- If you have any of the following items bring them:
 - Wire cutters
 - Round Nose Pliers
 - Tin Snips
 - Embossing tool such as a stylus
 - Hammer with a textured head

NOTE: These items are not required; I will have these items and will share with you. However, if you do have them, you won't have to "wait your turn."

Not required, but nice to have:

- *Art Quilt Workbook* by Jane Davila and Elin Waterston
