BB Bags Pattern- You'll need this to reference for the fabric requirements , it varies depending on which size you are making. The pattern calls for three fabrics. For ease, so I don't mix up pattern pieces I usually only use two fabrics. One fabric as the lining and one as the outside, but you may use as many or as little as you like. You'll just be labeling a lot more! 😊

Depending on the size of the bag you want to do you'll need either two 7" zippers or two 9" zippers.

Fusible Midweight Interfacing- I use Pellon Sheer weight

I also traced all of my templates onto Template Plastic. This makes them easier to use as well as durable so they keep well for a long time. I still have my original templates.

I also like to put a Velcro Closure on my BB Bags- I use the Fabric Fusion Velcro, it comes in a package of 3 or 4 feet (you'll only need about 1") but it's a great product to have around your stash.

This bag is fun to embellish with a huge funky button or broach, so if that's something you want to do, feel free to bring that to class as well.

I finish this bag binding by hand because I prefer that method. I will show you how to do this in class if that's the method of finishing you'd like to do. If that's the case you'll need a hand sewing needle- I use the milliners size 10 needles.
