

Easy Striped Table Runner

We will be making a very easy and yet striking table runner from your choice of striped fabric – consider Christmas, floral, novelty. This would make a great Christmas gift (after you make one for yourself, of course!) You can actually make two runners from the fabric purchased for this class.

Working Sewing machine
¼ inch foot or patchwork foot
Walking foot
Sewing machine needles

1 1/2 yard striped fabric

1 1/2 yards for the backing

Straight pins

Thread

Rotary cutter / Scissors

60 degree Triangle ruler or rectangular ruler with 60 degree marking

Piece of batting – minimum 18 inches x 48 inches (for one of the table runners)

The fabric required will make two 45 inch table runners. It is possible to make one longer, and I can show you how in class. You may need a longer piece of fabric for the backing however. Think about using a different seasonal print for the backing so the table runner can be reversible!
