

Class Supply List

Class: Fearless Machine Quilting- Trapunto

Instructor: Carol Wight Jones

Note: Although the sample has 3 feathered plumes, we will do only 1 in class.

Fabric Requirements:

- Top fabric piece about 14 by 14 inches square (Choose a somewhat plain fabric; you want to be able to see your Trapunto design.)
- Thin cotton batting piece, 15 by 15 inches square
- Backing fabric, 17 by 17 inches square
- Thick polyester batting, 15 by 15 inch square

Tools and Notions Required:

- Wash-away thread
- Wash-away marking pen (such as the blue marker)
- Quilting thread- choose cotton such as Mettler Silk finish cotton or Aurofil (Both are size 50)
- Safety pins for basting quilt **NOTE:** Please do *not* baste your quilt before coming to class. You will just have to take it apart.
- Sewing Machine, power cord, and foot pedal in good working order. You must be able to drop the feed dogs to do free motion quilting.
- Extra empty bobbin
- Free motion quilting foot
- Small sharp scissors (If you have the appliqué duck-bill scissors, bring those.)
- Quilting gloves if you have them
