**Description of Class:** You will be guided through several exercises to learn some fun and innovative ways of finishing the edges of your quilts. Several of my samples for other classes showcase some of the edge finishes we will do in class.

## **Fabric Requirements:**

- If you have some small quilts (no larger that 16 inches) and want to use those for some of the exercises that is fine.
- You will need several (7-8) small sample quilts. These can be about 6 inches by 10 or 12 inches.
- Please have all of your samples lightly quilted before coming to class. Leave one of your sample quilts unquilted at least 2 inches from all edges.
- Several fat quarters or yardage (1 yard should be sufficient) you will need this for some of the binding choices.

## **Tools and Notions Required:**

- Sewing Machine in good working order, power cord and foot pedal
- Rotary cutting equipment
- If you have a rotary cutter with a scalloped or pinking blade, bring it
- Fusible Web such as Steam-a-seam2
- Cording about 1/8 inch width, one yard should be plenty for sample
- Bulky overlock foot (Bernina #12) or zipper foot
- Open toed embroidery foot (Bernina #20)
- Walking foot
