Class: Mixed Media – Embellishments 8

Description of Class: In this class we will play with some other unconventional items, such as paper, labels, photos, clip art, and other fun items. Be prepared to have some fun!

Fabric Requirements:

- You will need several fabric pieces about 8 inches square – or you can use yardage or fat quarters. Choose fabrics that work well together in case you want to put them together in a quilt. Choose various compatible fabrics, light , medium and dark colors. Some of the lighter colors should be somewhat plain or marbled. Batiks are a good choice. It is better to have too much fabric than not enough, as we will be making several samples.
- It will be your choice whether to put these samples together into a quilt. If you choose to do so, you will also need to bring backing and batting.

Tools and Notions Required:

- Basic sewing supplies
- Fusible web, such as Steam-a-seam2 (1 yard)
- Rotary cutting supplies
- Sewing machine, power cord and foot pedal
- Open toed embroidery foot would be helpful (Bernina #20)
- Some kind of burnishing tool-an old credit card will work fine
- Sponge paint brush, 1 to 2 inches wide
- Plastic to protect your work surface-a kitchen garbage bag works nicely
- If you have a brayer, bring it. I will have one for you to borrow.
- Stamp and ink if you have any. I will also have these items for your use.

These books are not required, but are nice to have. There are lots of fun things to do.
