Snow Skirt Debby Carter

Working Sewing machine
Sewing machine needles
Zipper foot
Walking foot can be helpful, but not necessary

Scissors

Snow Skirt Pattern

1 yard pattern tracing material to trace your size

1 yard parka lining (6 or 8 oz.) - you will need 1 1/2 yard for XL or larger/longer

1 1/8 yard rip stop fabric – 1 1/2 yard for XL or larger/longer

26" 2 way zipper for 27"-28" skirt (28" separating zipper for 29'-30" skirt)

9 inch or longer zipper for outside pocket

1/4" wide Wonder Tape (you could share a package with another student)

One package double fold bias tape (color does not matter as it will be hidden completely)

4" stretchy cord (supplied by teacher)

One small shank button

Thread – to match the rip stop fabric as you will be doing top-stitching

1 1/2 yard trim (optional) – you may need more for longer or larger sizes

Prior to class:

You may want to take a look at the variety of rip stop fabrics we have to choose from, as well as the trims. Also, consider using non-black zippers to add some color and personality to your skirt. If you own an embroidery machine, you will have opportunity between classes to add a design of your choice to the skirt.
