

Merry Kuspuk Moose – by Karen Smith

You will need to purchase the Merry Kuspuk Moose Pattern for this class, but for your convenience the supply list for both the pattern and basic sewing supplies are listed below:

Merry Kuspuk Moose Supply List

- 1/8 yd. muslin, tea dyed a medium dark shade (fat quarter)
- 1/4 yd. cotton fabric for dress and hood (fat quarter)
- 30 inches of baby ric rac to match dress fabric
- 7 inches of 1/4 - 1/2 embroidered ribbon trim to coordinate
- 5" X 1/2" piece of fur – fake or real
- 1 small tuft of gray or brown lambs wool or lofty yarn for “hairdo”
- 1 twig for antlers
- Thread to match body fabric, kuspuk fabric and ric rac
- Pearl cotton thread to match
- Brown acrylic paint for hooves and paint brush
- 2 small black beads (approx. 3mm)
- Brown embroidery floss or hand quilting thread for facial features
- Polyfil
- Blush

BEFORE CLASS: Please trace body, arm, leg, ear and clothing templates onto template plastic or manila folder and cut out on traced line. Trace exactly as shown in pattern – do not add a seam allowance.

In addition to the above supplies, you will need the following basic supplies:

- Template plastic or thin cardboard (manila file folder works great)
- Mechanical pencil
- White Pencil (for dark fabrics)
- Turning tool (sturdy straw and blunt wood chopstick)
- Stuffing tool
- Stuffing – Fairfield Premium Polyfil
- Scissors – sewing pair for fabrics and paper pair to cut templates
- Sewing machine in good working order, open toe foot and sharp needles
- Sewing supplies – straight pins, hand sewing needles, doll needles, and your favorite miscellaneous sewing supplies
- Fray check
- Hand sewing needles – large eye to accommodate perle cotton and hand quilting thread or embroidery floss.
