

Snow Vest

Working Sewing machine

Sewing machine needles, thread to coordinate with rip stop fabric

Walking foot is necessary

Fabric scissors and seam ripper

Kwik Sew pattern #2896

1 yard pattern tracing material to trace your size

1yard parka lining (6 or 8 oz)

1 yard rip stop fabric

Small piece of coordinating fleece or ultrasuede for inner collar (optional) – 22” x 5”

22” separating zipper (24” separating zipper for L or XL)

5 inch or longer zipper for inside security pocket

One piece cotton fabric 3” x 7”, interfaced (used for zipper insertion and will not be seen)

Thread that coordinates with the rip stop fabric

1 1/2 yard trim (optional for waist); 2/3 yard will be needed to trim the collar if desired

Prior to class:

Determine your size for the vest. The store sample is a **size large with 8 oz parka lining**, if you care to try it on. Trace the following pieces: front- 1, side panel- 3, back- 2, pocket- 12 and 2 collar pieces- 10&11. Trace carefully, as close to the original lines as possible and making sure that the pattern does not move while you are tracing. If you need help with this, please call ahead and come in some time while I am working – I would be happy to help you trace your pattern pieces at the store. You will want to have this done prior to the first day of class. There will be a small adjustment to the back and side panel pieces.
