March 1st Mark hem, hem, and fastener. Skirt finished.

March 8th Compare body measurements to pattern measurements to make alterations to Pant pattern. Cut out pants and ready for fitting.

March 15th Fit pants, alter, and zipper.

March 29th Waistband, hem, and fastener. Pants finished.

April 5th Compare body measurements to pattern measurements to make alterations to the Top pattern. Cut out top and be ready for fitting.

April 12th Fit top, alter, and facings.

April 19th Hem and fasteners. Top finished.
