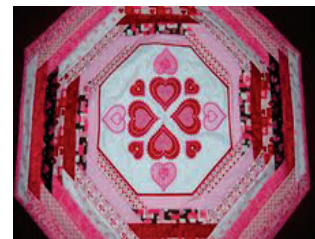


Go! Heart Table Runner (1-710)
