SNOW REMOVAL

How does Brigham City's street snow removal program work?

Brigham City's snow removal is designed to keep the City's roadways safe to travel. Safety is our first priority. School zones and main roadways are plowed first. After the area is plowed, collector and arterials are plowed, followed by subdivision streets, cul-de-sacs and dead end roads.

Where can I put the snow shoveled from my sidewalk and driveway?

You are encouraged to push or throw the snow onto your own property. It is illegal to throw or push the snow into any street. Pushing the snow into the streets can make the roads more dangerous for automobiles and snowplows.

Can I park my vehicle on the street during the winter season?

"No person shall park or allow to be parked a motor vehicle, trailer, or any other obstruction on any street in Brigham City between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. during a period of 48 hours immediately following any snowfall on the streets of Brigham City." {Brigham City Code 24.01.210}

Removal of snow from the sidewalk

"It shall be unlawful for any person or entity owning, having charge or control or occupying any real estate abutting on any street within the city to fail, refuse, or neglect to keep the sidewalk in front of such property free from litter, snow, ice and obstructions. {Brigham City Code 24.01.200}
