

REGISTER YOUR BICYCLE. IT'S THE LAW!

The Brigham City Police Department handles dozens of stolen bicycle calls every few months. They also have dozens of bicycles turned in that people find after they are abandoned. Unfortunately, a lot of bicycles that are found are never returned to their owner because the police have no way of identifying who they belong to. There is an easy way to help keep track of your bicycle. All you have to do is bring it to the Police Department and register it. Registration is an easy process that only takes about five minutes and only costs one dollar (\$1.00). A lot of people don't realize that a City Ordinance exists that requires all bicycles in Brigham City be registered. Once your bicycle is registered, it helps us to identify you as the owner when it is found. It also gives us information needed to help track down your bicycle if it is stolen. Please take a few minutes, come to the Police Department with your bicycle, and get it registered. It is the law!
