## STREET LEGAL OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLES

In conjunction with Senate Bill 181, Brigham City has passed an ordinance opening the city streets to "Street Legal Off-Highway Vehicles."

Effective October 1, 2008, off-highway vehicles that meet safety inspection, registration and insurance requirements will become legal to drive on the streets of Brigham City. Operators must have a valid Utah drivers license with a motorcycle endorsement.

Utah Traffic Code 41-6a-1509 provides detailed information on Street Legal Off-Highway Vehicles. The code prohibits the driving of these vehicles on or across interstate highways (I-15) and limited access highways (SR-89/91, 1100 South). It also sets a maximum speed limit of 45 m.p.h. or the posted limit, whichever is less. Drivers/passengers under the age of 18 must wear a DOT-approved helmet in accordance with the motorcycle operators requirements.

Off-highway vehicles and operators NOT meeting the requirements stated in 41-6a-1509 are not legal on Brigham City streets. Violators will be cited and vehicles subject to impound.
