Application for Brigham City Main Street Flyway Design contest.

Line drawing* design entries can be submitted electronically, (PDF file preferred) to: jjeppsen@brighamcity.utah.gov or delivered in person on an 8.5 by 11 inch piece of paper to the Fine Arts Center, the Bear River Bird Refuge Education Center, or the Brigham City Museum-Gallery. (* think coloring book lines)

We would like to highlight birds that frequent our local bird refuge. The refuge has silhouette check lists of birds available upon request. We suggest you pick your favorite bird from these lists. We are hoping to represent a variety of birds, especially the larger more popular ones. Designs can be funky, exaggerated, humorous or artistic. It would be best to include a little bit of habitat or more than one of the smaller birds to allow the art work to be attached to a frame on all sides. Please feel free to include a humorous (or serious) title. Most bird panels or renderings work best in a 2 to 3 proportion. That is two wide by three tall. While the final product will be about 12 inches wide by 18 inches long, entries need to be closer to 6” wide by 9” tall so they can be scanned and used with a laser wood cutter that will enlarge them as needed.

Chosen birds and their designs will be cut out of ¼ inch plywood and secured in a 1 ½ inch to 2 inch wide frame. We are planning to have one artist and one woodworker produce all the chosen entries to allow for visual unity. The designers and community groups will join together to paint them.

The goal is to have 5 to 10 completed weather vanes/bird hangings to unveil in downtown Brigham City for display on the Flyway at the end of April. Winners will be contacted in early March and recognized at the unveiling in April.

Please submit one application per entry. There are no restrictions regarding the number of designs you submit.
