

FIRE RESTRICTION ORDER

This FIRE RESTRICTON ORDER is issued pursuant to Title 11 of the Brigham City Code and the International Fire Code adopted herein.

WHEREAS, extremely dry conditions have created a high risk of fire in the area; and

WHEREAS, based upon the dry conditions and the high risk of fire, the Brigham City Fire Marshal has approved the issuance of this fire restriction order; and

WHEREAS, the Brigham City Fire Marshal has determined that this fire restriction order is necessary to protect the heath, safety and welfare of the citizens of Brigham City and their property as well as protect forest, rangelands and watersheds from the destruction caused by fire: and

WHEREAS, the Brigham City Fire Marshal has further determined that this restriction order is necessary and in keeping with the expressed intent of the International Fire Code to provide "a reasonable level of life safety and property protection from the hazards of fire, explosions or dangerous conditions."

NOW THEREFORE: effective at 12:01 am July 3, 2012, it is hereby ORDERED as follows:

1. Prohibited Acts. The following acts are prohibited on all private and City owned lands in the "Area Description" set forth herein:
 - a. Setting, building, maintaining, attending, or using open fires of any kind, except campfires built within the facilities provided for them in approved campgrounds, picnic areas, or permanently improved places of habitation.
 - b. Smoking, except within an enclosed vehicle or building, a developed recreation site or in an area at least three (3) feet in diameter that is barren or cleared to mineral soils.
 - c. Discharging, or using any kind of fireworks or tracer ammunition or other pyrotechnic devices.
 - d. Operating a chainsaw without spark arresters, operating motorized equipment for any purpose.
 - e. Operating any motorized vehicle off designed roads or trails.
 - f. Blasting, welding, or any other activities which generate flames or flammable materials.


2. Area Description
 - a. See attached map of the restricted areas
 - b. See back of order to description of restrictions

3. Exempted Individuals. The following individuals are exempted from the provisions of this fire restriction order:
 - a. Any individual with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act issued by the City Fire Marshal.
 - b. Any Federal, State, County or City law enforcement officer or fire fighting personnel engaged in the lawful performance of their official duties.

4. Effective Date. This fire restriction order shall be effective from 12:01, July 2, 2012 and will remain in effect until rescinded by the City Fire Marshal.

5. Violation. Any violation of this fire restriction order shall be punishable as a violation of Title 11 of the Brigham City Code and fire suppression costs will be recovered as outlined in Title 11 (Cost Recovery).

Everything East of the following described line:

- Beginning at the north Brigham City boundary located at 1500 North & Main Street
- South on Main Street to 900 North
- East on 900 North to Highland Blvd
- Southeast on Highland Blvd to Beecher Ave
- West on Beecher Ave to Eliason Ave
- South and West on Eliason Ave to Poplar Dr.
- North on Poplar Dr. to 100 North
- West on 100 North to 1000 East
- South on 1000 East to Eliason Ave
- West on Eliason Ave to 700 East
- South on 700 East to Forest Street
- West on Forest Street to 600 East
- South on 600 East to 700 South
- South on a straight line from the intersection of 600 East & 700 South to 1100 South
- West on 1100 South to Michelle Dr.
- South on Michelle Dr. to the Brigham City/Perry City boundaries
