

Bylaws for Miss Cleveland Pageant

In order to provide adequate opportunity for the girls of Cleveland Town to reign as royalty by participating in the annual Miss Cleveland Pageant, the following bylaws are adopted:

Only girls who live within the boundaries and outlying areas of Cleveland that affiliate Cleveland as their present "Home Town" are eligible to enter. Girls must plan to reside here for the year of her reign.

The winner of Miss Cleveland is encouraged (if she's of age) to participate in the Miss Emery County Pageant as a representative of Cleveland Town. Cleveland town will sponsor her in this pageant.

Girls must pay the fee and submit their entry form by the deadline set annually. No girl may enter after rehearsals have begun. Girls are required to attend rehearsals as scheduled.

Girls must be the age in her category, as of the date of the pageant.

After a girl has won the title in a given category, she may not enter the pageant again until she qualifies for the next age group.

The parents of the reigning royalty are expected to create a float by July 1. The parents need to also make arrangements to transport the float to the various county parades. Cleveland Town has a budget to include the cost of the float.

The royalty is expected to wear their crowns and banners to all activities during the Cleveland Days Celebration and ride the float representing Cleveland in parades entered by the Town; ie, Heritage days, Emery County Fair Parade, Elmo Days, Peach Days, Melon Days.
