TURNOVER STARS

26" x 69" table runner or 55" sq. wall quilt or tree skirt

Need a long runner for your holiday table? Or how about a tree skirt to hold all of Santa's surprises? Moda's precut Turnovertm triangles are the simple answer to your quilting prayers. Choose your project - one Turnovertm each - or make them both!

ASSEMBLY

For Each Star, PIECE A TOTAL OF (12) BIAS SQUARES from 6" TurnoverTM triangles. Lay (2) selected TurnoverTM triangles right sides together; stitch on long side. Press toward darker fabric; trim to 5 ½" square each.

GREEN STAR - center - (4) green/gold bias sq. star points - (8) green/tan bias sq.

BLACK STAR - center - (4) black/gold bias sq.

star points - (8) black/tan bias sq.

RED STAR - center - (4) red/gold bias sq.

star points - (8) red/tan bias sq.

Lay out bias squares and light corner squares for each star, as shown. Sew blocks together in rows; press seams in alternating rows in opposite directions. Sew rows together; press. Each star measures 20 ½" square.

Lay out (3) star blocks in a horizontal row with sashing strips in between. Sew **SASHING STRIPS** between blocks; press toward sashing strips. Center of table runner measures $20 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $63 \frac{1}{2}$ ".

OUTER BORDER - Measure your quilt top; piece $3\frac{1}{2}$ " border strips end-to-end and trim to length of long sides of runner (63 $\frac{1}{2}$ "). Add to table runner; press toward borders. Trim end borders to length (26 $\frac{1}{2}$ "). Stitch to ends of table runner; press. Table runner measures $26\frac{1}{2}$ " x $69\frac{1}{2}$ ".

SANDWICH quilt top, batting and backing using the method of your choice. **MACHINE QUILT**-in-the-ditch around star center, points and borders; echo quilt about 2" away from star points. Trim and square batting and backing. **BIND** with 2 ½" wide double binding pieced to about 210".

SNOWFLAKE APPLIQUE


From light tan woven plaid, cut bias strips (45° diagonal of fabric):

A - (6) 3/8" x 21" bias strips

B - (6) 3/8" x 17" bias strips

C - (12) $\frac{3}{8}$ " x 7" bias strips

D - (24) 3/8" x 5" bias strips



Lay out (2) A strips in an "x" and (2) B strips in a "+" pattern on each quilted star, as shown. Pin in place. Stitch thru center of bias strips with light tan cotton thread. Position C strips on A strips, folding in a "V" at center, close to gold bias square seam line; pin in place. Fold D strips in a "V" toward ends of A and B snowflake tips; pin in place. Stitch thru center of bias strips with light tan cotton thread. Bias strips will softly curl and fray with washing, but will not unrayel.
