



## It's a snap!

### How to install magnetic snaps the Eazy Peazy way

Mark a center point on the wrong side of fabric where you want the center of the snap. Do for both sides.

Use the thin washer to mark two vertical cut lines. Use a Pigma or similar thin permanent marker. Cut on the drawn lines.

Use the washer and mark the same lines on two 1"x1" pieces of folded fleece or Timtex (preferred). This is used to keep the prongs from damaging the fabric. Cut on the drawn lines.

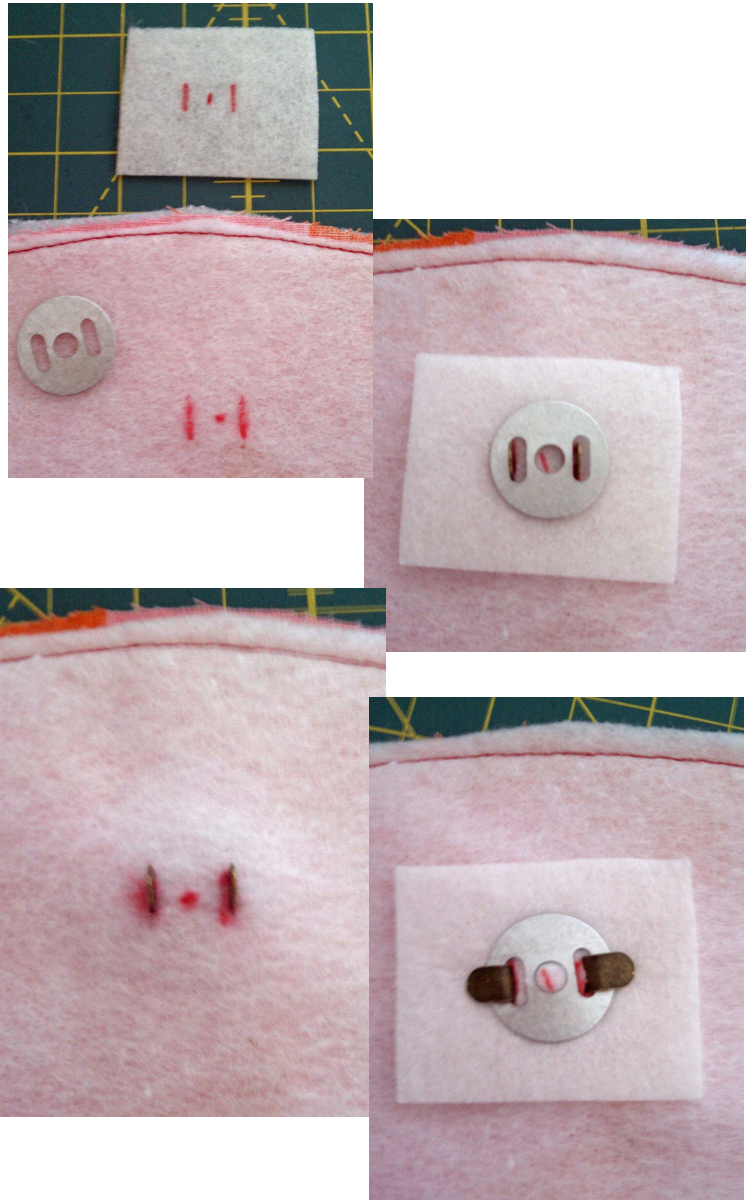
From right side of fabric, insert the prongs of the snap. Now put the prongs through the fleece or Timtex and then through the washer.

Use some scrap fabric to protect your snap. With piers, pull the first prong to the outside and crimp. Repeat for the other side.

Note: Prongs may also go towards the center. That works, too!

Now simply repeat for the other side.
