- FREESTYLE: (Boats made prior to regatta– not limited on amount of cardboard, duct tape or construction time) One or two riders, Duct tape and cardboard only, no other structural materials. Decorative materials and costumes are OK.

Each team will be given cardboard, duct tape, and a 1x2x8ft. piece of wood at 4:00. Participants are responsible to provide their own utility knives for cutting, life vests, paddles, and markers/spray paint for decoration.

Boat number must be written or painted in a visible place on the boat prior to race times.

All drivers must have a signed liability/release form in order to participate.
