# August 7 & September 4: Embroidery Project Club----Lace and Blitz

Prior to class wash and iron the shirt to be used. Starch the area on the back from the waist up to add stabilizer and ease of sewing. I use Niagara Heavy Duty and I usually spray, dry, spray again, dry, and press. The shirt should be flexible and bend slightly.

#### **General Supplies**

- \*Sewing & Embroidery Machine, power cord, foot pedal, instruction book
- \*Feet: Q foot
- \*Hoops: 240 x 150 or 260 x 200, and 120 x 120 Hoop clips
- \*Needles: #90 or #80 Microtex, #80 quilting, and #80 & 90 universal
- \*Stabilizers: Aqua Magic Dissolvable and Tear Away
- \*Thread:
  - Embroidery thread: Two values of the same color. Sample has Haskins #148, and R.A. #2286, tulip
  - Sewing thread to match color of blouse and design
  - Bobbin embroidery 60 wt.
  - Invisible thread

\*Designs: Design Collection #166 Vintage (Design #216602)

(Order from my embroideries.com or order the collection from Patty) I have already isolated the small flowers from this design. If you choose a different design, please email me this week and I will try to isolate yours---not all designs will allow one to isolate a part easily. barbara919@aol.com

- \* Cotton/polyester blouse
- \* Three 10 x 12 inch pieces of Polyester chiffon. Sample has white. I used Casas from JoAnn's.
