Try Before You Buy

Students are encouraged to use Pfaff and Husqvarna Viking demonstration machines during class This is an ideal opportunity to use all aspects of the world's leading sewing machine before making your purchase. Students are also encouraged to machine embroider designs in pieced blocks made during class. Machine embroidery enhances block designs and further individualizes projects. In class students learn rotary cutting, machine chain piecing, and layout of quilt blocks and borders. Students finish their project by machine quilting and binding the edge.

No class fee will be transferred, credited or refunded later than one week prior to the start of class.
