

# Artful Machine Quilting

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## Supply List

- Sewing machine with a darning, hopping, or quilting foot and the ability to cover or drop feed dogs.
- Three small quilt sandwiches-
  1. 18" x 22" (fat quarter) of large print floral fabric, backing fabric and batting measuring at least 18" x 22".
  2. Muslin fabric or other plain solid colored fabric measuring 18" x 22", backing fabric and batting measuring at least 18" x 22".
  3. Small pieced quilt top, backing fabric and batting measuring at least 22" x 22".

To make small quilt, cut 16 5 1/2" squares of solid colored or tonal fabric and stitch them into four patch units, then stitch these units into a 16 patch quilt top measuring approximately 20 1/2" x 20 1/2".

- Thread- a 100% 40wt or 50wt cotton thread will be good to start with. If you are interested in experimenting with other types of threads, please bring them
- Basic quilting supplies including straight pins, seam ripper, scissors and/or snips for cutting thread. You will not need a rotary cutter or mat for this class.
- Fabric marker and/or pencil
- If you like, please bring a quilt you would like to discuss quilting options about.

## Notes on Artful Machine Quilting

During the course of this class, we will be exploring a variety of popular machine quilting motifs. We will practice first with the muslin quilt sandwich and then graduate to quilting on the small pieced quilt top. By the end of the class, students will have a 16 patch sampler of quilting motifs for reference and inspiration for future quilting projects.
