A BLENDABLE CURVE TECHNIQUE

This is a great quick and easy project to help you on your way to learning the Blendable Curve technique. Please feel free to bring scraps to class to learn the technique and then if you like the process you can pick your final fabrics and make one for each friend and family member, or go crazy and make a full size quilt.

The Center Square Fabric is the same for “both” Color Ways;
Cut 4 - 2” X 2” Squares

Light Color Way:

#1 1 - 2” Strip the Width of Fabric
#2 2 - 2” Strip the Width of Fabric
#3 3 - 2” Strip the Width of Fabric
#4 3 - 2” Strip the Width of Fabric

Dark Color Way:

#1 1- 2” Strip the Width of Fabric
#2 2- 2” Strip the Width of Fabric
#3 3-2” Strip the Width of Fabric
#4 3-2” Strip the Width of Fabric

1 yard of background fabric: this is for the side & corner setting triangles.
¼ yard for inner border
1/3 yard for binding
1 yard backing

The rest of your supplies:

Sewing machine
Neutral Thread
Rotary Cutter
18 x 24” Mat
12 ½” x 12 ½” Square Ruler
Scissors
Small Trash Bag
4 – 6” x 6” Scrap Squares.
Pressing surface & Iron

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
