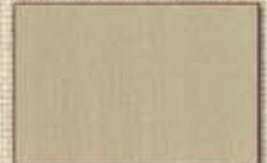

Dashing Home

Please read all instructions carefully before starting. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut from selvage to selvage unless otherwise stated.

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - cut 2 - 3 1/2" strips, subcut 17 - 3 1/2" squares
cut 4 - 9 1/2" squares
Outer border - cut 9 - 4 1/2" stripes, sew end to end and subcut: 2 - 4 1/2" x 87 1/2" (SIDES) and 2 - 4 1/2" x 75 1/2" (TOP and BOTTOM)
BINDING - cut 9 - 2 1/4" strips, sew end to end and press in half.

Fabric B - cut 12 - 3 7/8" strips, subcut 60 - 3 7/8" squares,  cut in half diagonally for 120 triangles. OR pair with **Fabric I** and use 3" finished Half Square Triangles on a Roll or Thangles - make 120 units.

cut 2 - 4" strips, subcut 18 - 4" squares

Fabric C - cut 4 - 3 1/2" strips for 9-Patches

Fabric D - cut 12 - 2 1/2" strips, sew end to end and subcut: 2 - 2 1/2" x 63 1/2" (SIDES) and 4 - 2 1/2" x 67 1/2" (Top and BOTTOM)

Fabric E - cut 4 - 2 1/2" strips, sew end to end and subcut 2 - 2 1/2" x 67 1/2" (TOP and BOTTOM)

Fabric F - cut 7 - 2" strips (pair with **Fabric I**)

cut 2 - 4" strips, subcut 18 - 4" squares

Fabric G - cut 1 - 3 1/2" strip, subcut 8 - 3 1/2" squares, draw a diagonal line on the backside of all squares

1st Border - cut 2 - 1" x 27 1/2" (SIDES) and cut

2 - 1" x 28 1/2" (TOP and BOTTOM)

2nd Border - cut 2 - 1" x 35 1/2" (SIDES) and

2 - 1" x 36 1/2" (TOP and BOTTOM)

3rd Border - cut 2 - 2" x 42 1/2" (SIDES) and

2 - 2" x 45 1/2" (TOP and BOTTOM)

cut 4 - 2 1/2" strips, sew end to end and subcut:

2 - 2 1/2" x 67 1/2" (TOP and BOTTOM)

Fabric H - cut 5 - 3 1/2" strips (for 9-Patches)

Fabric I - cut 7 - 2" strips (to be paired with Fabric F)

cut 12 - 3 7/8" strips, subcut 60 - 3 7/8" squares,

 cut squares in half diagonally for 120 triangles. OR Use 3" finished Half Square Triangles on Roll or Thangles for 120 units. (Pair with Fabric B)

2. Piecing Order:

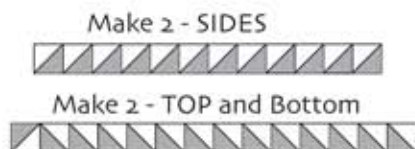
1. Make 120 - 3" finished (3 1/2" unf.) B/I Half Square Triangles. Sew individual triangles together or use your favorite method.

Press to the darker fabric. Make 68 units for Churn Dash blocks and 52 for Sawtooth border.

Sawtooth Border - sew two rows of units together for both SIDE borders. Sew two rows of 14 units together for the TOP and BOTTOM borders.



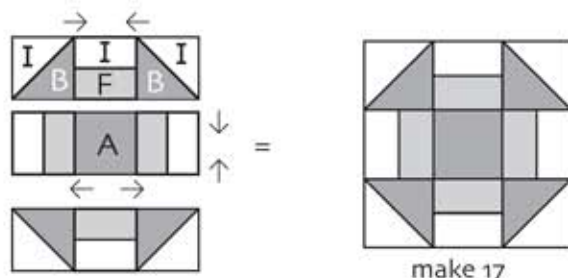

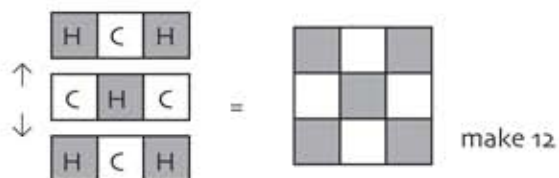
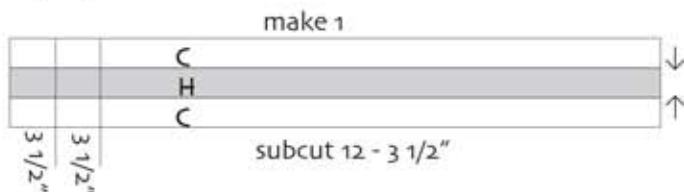
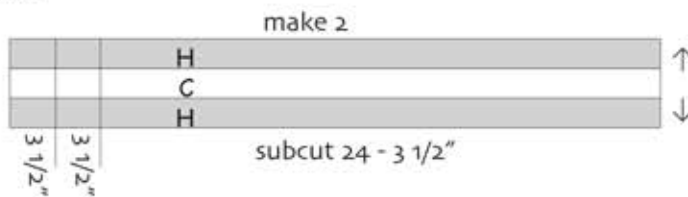
2. Sew seven panels of **Fabric I** and **F** (2" strips), subcut 68 - 3 1/2" segments.



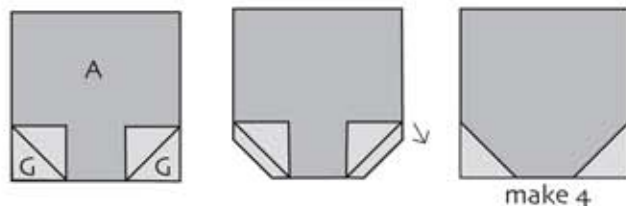
3. Make 17 - 9" finished Churn Dash Blocks (9 1/2" unf.). Sew blocks together for rows.



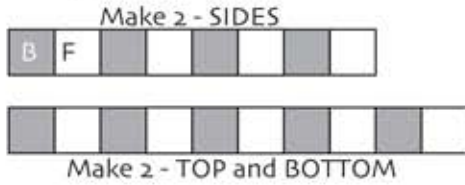
4. Make 12 - 9" finished 9-Patch Blocks (9 1/2" unf.) First, make 2 panels of Fabric H/C/H, subcut 24 - 3 1/2" segments for the first and third row. Next, make one panel of Fabrics C/H/C, subcut 12 - 3 1/2" segments for the second row. Sew block together by rows.



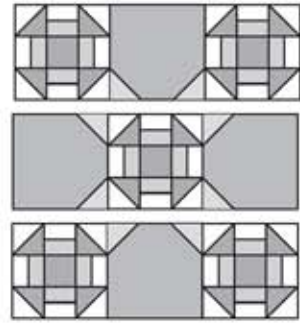
5. Make 4 - 9" finished Snowball Blocks (9 1/2" unf.) Place 2 G squares over opposite corners of A square, right sides together and match corners. Stitch ON the drawn diagonal line, trim 1/4" from seam and press outward. Repeat for all 4 blocks.



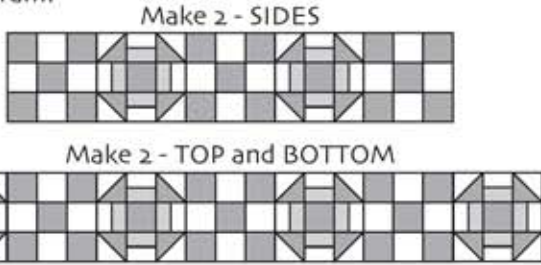
6. Squares Border: Sew Fabric B and F squares together according to the diagram.



8. Sew CENTER Square by sewing Churn Dash blocks and Snowball blocks.



7. Sew Churn Dash/9-Patch Border according to the diagram:



9. Sew quilt together by adding individual borders around the CENTER square, SIDES first, then TOP and BOTTOM, according to the diagram. (Inner borders are not true to scale.)

10. Quilt measures approximately 75" x 87". Make backing (Fabric J) at least 6" larger than top.
