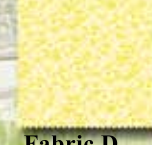

Bunny Hop Crib Quilt

Please read all instructions carefully before starting. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut from selvage to selvage unless otherwise stated.

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - **cut 1 - 17" x 23 1/2" center panel by centering design evenly

Fabric B - cut lengthwise: cut 2 identical border stripes - 3 1/2" x 25 1/2"

Outer Border - cut 4 identical border stripes - 7 1/2" x approximately 63" (to be mitered)

Fabric C - cut 10 - 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares by centering designs evenly

Fabric E - cut 2 - 1 1/2" strips, subcut 8 - 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" and 8 - 1 1/2" x 5 1/2"

Fabric F - cut 3 - 1 1/2" strips, subcut 12 - 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" and 12 - 1 1/2" x 5 1/2"

Fabric G - ** cut 2 - 1 1/2" x 17" (SIDES)
cut 2 - 2 1/4" x 25 1/2" (TOP and BOTTOM)

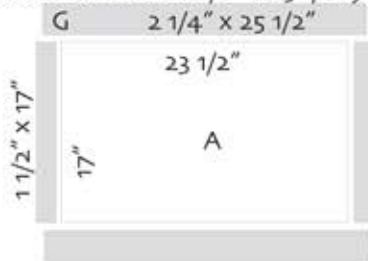
Fabric H - cut 2 - 1 1/2" x 25 1/2"

Inner Border - cut 5 - 1 1/2" strips

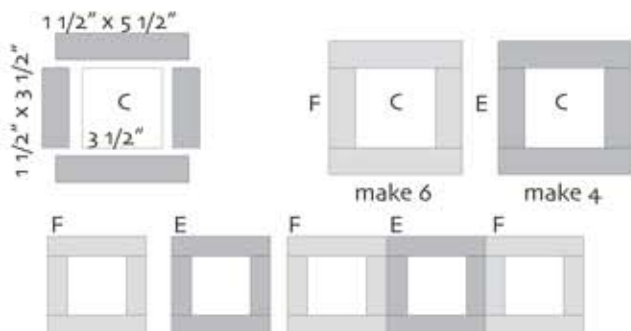
BINDING - cut 6 - 2 1/4" strips. sew end to end and press in half

2. Piecing Order:

1. Sew **G** borders around center panel (**A**), **SIDES** first, then **TOP** and **BOTTOM**. ** (If panel measurements are slightly different, cut **G** borders bigger and trim entire center block down to 20 1/2" x 25 1/2".)

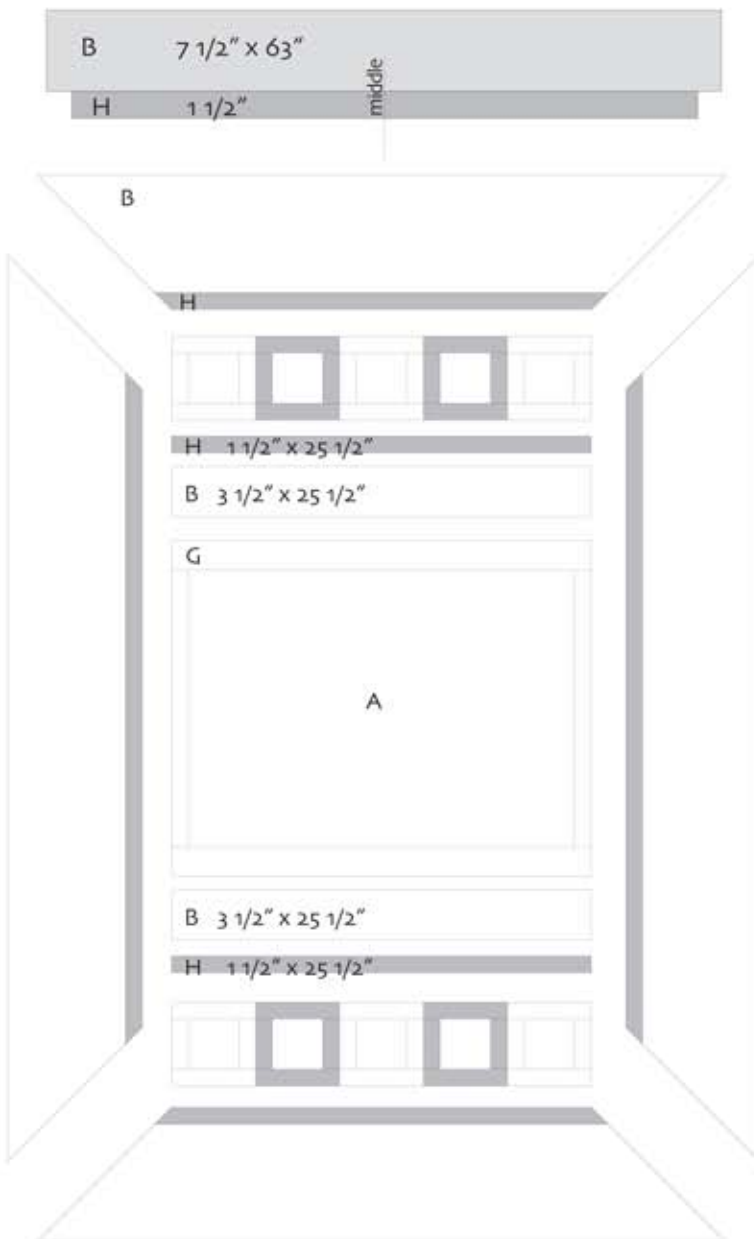


2. Sew borders around **C** squares, **SIDES** first then **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders. Make 6 with **F** borders and make 4 with **E** borders. Squares are 5" finished (5 1/2" unf.). Next, sew 2 rows of 5 blocks each alternating **F/C** and **E/C** blocks.



3. Next, sew **B** strip, **H** strip and rows of framed blocks above and below center square according to the diagram below.

4. Borders - Cut one of the 5 strips of Fabric **H** in half, then sew one of the halves to the end of a strip for each **SIDE**. Fold all borders (**B** and **H**) in half and mark middles. Next, sew **H** to one side of **B** by matching middle marks. Repeat for all borders. Sew borders to quilt, **SIDES** first, then **TOP** and **BOTTOM**. Sew mitered angles last.



5. The quilt measures approximately 42" x 55". Make backing (**Fabric D**) several inches larger than the top. Baste together top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**H**) and enjoy!!

Bunny Hop Stroller Quilt

Please read all instructions carefully before starting. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut from selvage to selvage unless otherwise stated.

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - cut 4 - 11 1/2" x 11 1/2" squares by centering designs evenly

Fabric C - cut 2 - 8 1/4" strips, subcut 5 - 8 1/4" squares

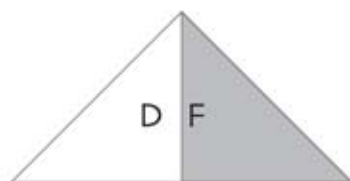
Fabric D - cut 1 - 6 3/4" strip, subcut 5 - 6 3/4" squares, cut each square in half diagonally from both directions ☒

Fabric E - BINDING - cut 4 - 2 1/4" strips, sew end to end and press in half

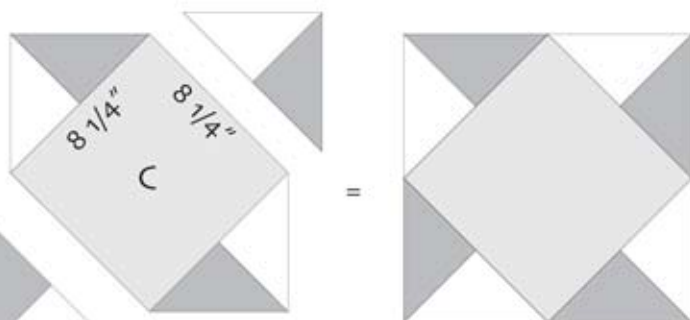
Fabric F - cut 1 - 6 3/4" strip, subcut 5 - 6 3/4" squares, cut each square in half diagonally from both directions ☒

2. Piecing Order:

1. Make 5 - 11" finished (11 1/2" unf.) Pieced Blocks. First, sew 20 pairs of **D/F** triangles. Next, sew triangle pairs to each side of **C** squares, opposite sides first.

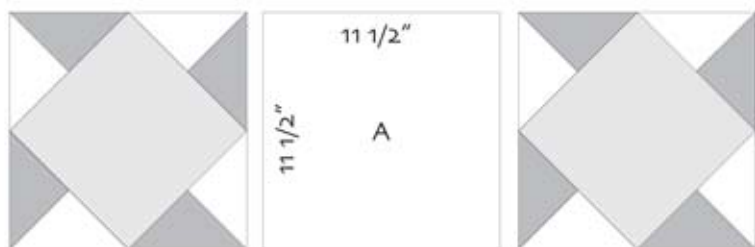

2. Sew rows of blocks together by alternating pieced blocks and **A** squares according to the diagram. Press toward **A** squares. Next, sew rows together.



3. Stroller quilt measures approximately 34" x 34". Make backing (**Fabric B**) several inches larger than the top. Baste together top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired.
