- 1 Panel - 19534-PNL-CTN-D (Village Panel)
- $7 / 8$ yd - 19532-BGE-CTN-D (Cocoa Truck)
- $7 / 8$ yd - 19525-MLT-CTN-D (Home Patch)
- 7/8 yd - 19526-BLU-CTN-D (Transport Globes)
- 7/8 yd - 19529-WHT-CTN-D (Skating Village)




## Additional Supplies Needed:

- 2 Lg bags - Polyester fiberfill (32 oz)
- Piecing and sewing thread
- Basic sewing supplies


## Befare Yau Begin

Read all instructions before beginning project. Do not pre-wash fabrics. Press fabrics with a dry iron on cotton setting before cutting. Use a $1 / 4$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~mm})$ seam allowance and sew fabrics with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted. Press seams in the direction of the arrows. wof $=$ width of fabric.

Note: A printed panel may become slightly skewed during the finishing process. Check if panel is square before cutting by folding the panel so selvages meet. If all edges do not meet, pull firmly from corner to corner until the edges meet. Continue until all corners are square.

## Cutting

Use a rotary cutter and ruler to cut the size and number of squares and rectangles from each fabric listed below. Note: Place border pieces as shown on directional fabric.

Cut 1 - $24 \frac{1 ⁄ 2}{2}$ in x $24^{1 ⁄ 2}$ in $(62.23 \mathrm{~cm} \times 62.23 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Cut $2-23 / 4$ in $\times 241 / 2$ in $(6.99 \mathrm{~cm} \times 62.23 \mathrm{~cm})$
Cut $2-23 / 4$ in $\times 20$ in $(6.99 \mathrm{~cm} \times 50.8 \mathrm{~cm})$

Flying Sleigh - 19530-BLU-CTN-D ( $1 / 2$ yd x wof $/ 45.72 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Cut $4-2$ in $\times 20$ in $(5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 50.8 \mathrm{~cm})$
Cut $4-2$ in $\times 17$ in ( $5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 43.18 \mathrm{~cm}$ )


Skating Village - 19529-WHT-CTN-D ( $7 / 8 \mathrm{yd} \times$ wof / $80.01 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Cut $1-241 / 2$ in $\times 241 / 2$ in $(62.23 \mathrm{~cm} \times 62.23 \mathrm{~cm})$
Cut $2-23 / 4$ in $\times 241 / 2$ in $(6.99 \mathrm{~cm} \times 62.23 \mathrm{~cm})$

Decorated Trees - 19528-GRNU-CTN-D ( $1 / 2 y$ yd x wof $/ 45.72 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Cut $4-2$ in $\times 20$ in ( $5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 50.8 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Cut 4-2 in $\times 17$ in ( $5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 43.18 \mathrm{~cm}$ )

## Sewing

1. Place a Flying Sleigh rectangle 2 in $\times 17$ in $(5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 43.18 \mathrm{~cm})$ on each side of the Fussy Cut Pillow Panel square 17 in $\times 17$ in $(43.18 \mathrm{~cm} \times 43.18 \mathrm{~cm})$ as shown in Diagram A. Pin RST; sew and press. Place a Flying Sleigh rectangle 2 in $\times 20$ in ( $5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 50.8 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) on the top and bottom. Pin RST; sew and press.

2. Refer to Diagram B to add a Cocoa Truck rectangle $2 \frac{3 / 4}{}$ in $\times 20$ in ( $6.99 \mathrm{~cm} \times 50.8 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) RST to each side. Then add a $23 / 4 \mathrm{in} \times 241 / 2$ in $(6.99 \mathrm{~cm} \times 62.23 \mathrm{~cm})$ rectangle to the top and bottom to create the Pillow Front which should measure $241 / 2$ in $\times 241 / 2$ in $(62.23 \mathrm{~cm} \times 62.23 \mathrm{~cm})$.

3. Place the Cocoa Truck Pillow Back $241 / 2$ in $\times 241 / 2$ in $(62.23 \mathrm{~cm} \times 62.23 \mathrm{~cm})$ and the Pillow Front RST with edges even and pin. Sew around the sides leaving a 6 in $(15.24 \mathrm{~cm})$ opening in the bottom as shown in Diagram C. Carefully clip corners and turn right side out. Push out corners and press edges flat. The Pillow should measure 24 in $\times 24$ in ( $60.96 \mathrm{~cm} \times 60.96 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

4. Insert fiberfill through opening as shown in Diagram D. Stuff firmly, but do not overstuff; hand stitch opening closed. Dia. D

5. Follow Steps 1 through 4 to make the remaining three Pillows.

## Finished Care Instructions

Machine wash in cold water; gentle cycle. Do not bleach. Tumble dry low.
