
CHRISTMAS JOYS PANEL QUILT







CHRISTMAS JOY PANEL QUILT

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 48" x 52"

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 Christmas Joys 5" Stacker (5-12250-42)

1 Christmas Joys Panel (P11256)

1 Yard Green Main (C12250)

½ Yard White Holly (C12254)

1/2 Yard Red Text (C12255)*

*Includes Binding

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting.

WOF- width of fabric.

Christmas Joys 5" Stacker

Select 8-5" squares and trim to measure 3%" x 5".

Select 8-5" squares and trim to measure 3½" x 5".

The rest will remain 5" square.

Panel

Fussy cut one center panel 23½" x 27½", centered over the large reindeer motif.

Fussy cut eight 5" x 5" squares, centered over the animal motif blocks on the top and bottom of panel.

Green Main

Cut 6 strips 5½" x WOF for Border 4.

White Holly

Cut 4 strips 2" x WOF for Border 1.

Cut 4 strips 2" x WOF for Border 3.

Red Text

Cut 7 strips 2½" x WOF for binding.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to the guilt photo for the placement of prints.

Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew side borders first. Press seams towards the borders.

Border 1

Side borders should be 27½". Top and bottom borders should be 26½".

Border 2

Sew 4- $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5" rectangles, 3- 5" squares and 1 fussy cut 5" square together (5" x $30\frac{1}{2}$ "). Press the seams in one direction. Repeat to make 2 side borders.

Sew 4- 3%" x 5" rectangles, 2- 5" squares and 3 fussy cut 5" squares together (5" x 35%"). Press the seams in one direction. Repeat to make the bottom border.

Border 3

Side borders should be 39½". Top and bottom borders should be 38½".

Border 4

Side borders should be 42½". Top and bottom borders should be 48½".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with the Red Text solid strips. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
