## Table Topper Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the 6 Large Blocks - Black (A):

- Fussy cut (2) $101 / 2$ " squares, both centered on a block.

From the Twinkle Basics - Black (B), cut:

- (1) 2 " $\times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 " $\times 101 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 2 " x $131 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 391 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
- (2) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 41 \frac{1}{2} "$ WOF strips.
-(6) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Tossed Sprig - Gray (C), cut:
- (6) $3^{1 / 2 "} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) $31 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Dotted Scroll - Black (D), cut:

- (3) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) $31 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Monochromatic Vine - Mustard (E), cut:
-(2) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $31 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Packed Pumpkins - Black (F), cut:

- (1) $61 / 2 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $61 / 2 "$ squares.


## From the Tossed Sprig - Black (G), cut:

- (2) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (17) $31 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Diagonal Plaid - Black (H), cut:

- (2) $31 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) $31 / 2 " \times 181 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Border Stripe - Black (I), cut:

- (4) 5 " $\times 54$ " Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.


## From the Texture - Gray (J), cut:

-(2) $31 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $31 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ strips.
From the Tossed Leaves - Gray (Backing), cut:

- (2) 58 " x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 58 " $\times 58$ " back.

Table Topper Block Assembly
Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Place (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric D square on the right side of (1) $31 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (16) Unit 1 strips total.
2. Place (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric D square on the left side of (1) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 2 strip (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (16) Unit 2 strips total.

3. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to the left end of (1) Unit 2 strip, Fabric D sides together, to make (1) Unit 3 strip (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (16) Unit 3 strips total.

4. Place (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric G square on the left side of (1) $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 61 / 2 "$ Fabric J strip, right sides together (Fig. 5). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 5). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance (Fig. 6).

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5. Place another $3^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric G square on the right side of the $31 / 2 " \times 1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric J strip, right sides together (Fig. 7). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 7). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 4 strip (Fig. 8).
6. Repeat Steps 4-5 to make (8) Unit 4 strips total.

7. Sew (1) 2" $\times 101 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $101 / 2 "$ Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2" x $131 / 2$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 5 square (Fig. 9). Trim the unit to measure
$121 / 2 " \times 121 / 2 "$. Repeat to make a second Unit 5 square.

8. Sew (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric E square to each end of (1) Unit 3 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 3 strip to each side of (1) Unit 5 square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) $181 / 2$ " Block One square (Fig. 10). Repeat to make a second Block One square.

9. Sew (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric E square to each end of (1) Unit 4 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 4 strip to each side of (1) $61 / 2$ " Fabric F square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together lengthwise to make (1) Unit 6 square (Fig. 11). Repeat to make a second Unit 6 square.

10. Sew (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric E square to each end of (1) Unit 3 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 3 strip to each side of (1) Unit 6 square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) $181 / 2 "$ Block Two square (Fig. 12). Repeat to make a second Block Two square.

11. Sew together (1) Block One square, (1) $31 / 2 " \times 181 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip and (1) Block Two square, in that order from left to right, to make the top row (Fig. 13).
12. Sew (1) $31 / 2 " \times 181 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip to each side of (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric G square to make the middle row (Fig. 13).
13. Sew together (1) Block Two square, (1) $31 / 2 " \times 181 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip and (1) Block One square, in that order from left to right, to make the bottom row (Fig. 13).
14. Sew together the (3) rows from Steps 11-13 lengthwise to make the $391 / 2 " \times 391 / 2 "$ Center Block (Fig. 13).

# FALL POTPOURRI 

## Table Set

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Table Topper Assembly
(Follow the Table Topper Layout in Figure 15 while assembling the quilt top.)
15. Sew (1) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 39^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 411 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
16. Center (1) 5 " $\times 54$ " Fabric I strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a $1 / 4 "$ from the top edge of the block and stop a $1 / 4$ " from the bottom edge. DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS. Repeat with the opposite side.
17. Repeat Step 16 to sew (1) 5 " $\times 54$ " Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start $1 / 4 "$ away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 14).
18. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 14), draw a 45 -degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make Topper top.

19. Layer and quilt as desired.
20. Sew the (6) $21 / 2$ " x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
21. Bind as desired.

From the 6 Large Blocks - Black (A):

- Fussy cut (4) $101 / 2 "$ squares, each centered on a block.

From the Twinkle Basics - Black (B), cut:

- (2) 2 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 " x $101 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2 " x $131 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Tossed Sprig - Gray (C), cut:

- (3) $31 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) $31 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Dotted Scroll - Black (D), cut:

- (2) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) $31 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Tossed Pumpkins - Mustard (E), cut:

- (4) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $21 / 2 " \times 181 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Monochromatic Vine - Mustard (F), cut:

- (8) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.

From the Texture - Gray (Backing), cut:

- (2) 22 " $\times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 19 " $\times 22$ " rectangles for the backs.

Place Mat Assembly
Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.
22. Sew (1) 2" x $101 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $101 / 2 "$ Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2" x $131 / 2$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 7 square (Fig. 16). Trim the block to measure
$121 / 2 " \times 121 / 2 "$. Repeat to make (4) Unit 7 squares total.

23. Place (1) $31 / 2$ " Fabric D square on the right side of (1) $31 / 2 " \times 1 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 17). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 17). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 8 strip (Fig. 18). Repeat to make (8) Unit 8 strips total.
24. Place (1) $31 / 2$ " Fabric D square on the left side of (1) $31 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 9 strip (Fig. 19). Repeat to make (8) Unit 9 strips total.

25. Sew (1) Unit 8 strip to the left end of (1) Unit 9 strip, Fabric D sides together, to make (1) Unit 10 strip (Fig. 20). Repeat to make (8) Unit 10 strips total.

26. Sew (1) Unit 10 strip to each side of (1) Unit 7 square to make (1) Unit 11 square (Fig. 21). Repeat to make (4) Unit 11 strips total.

27. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 181 / 2$ " Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) Unit 11 strip lengthwise to make (1) Place Mat Top (Fig. 22). Repeat to make (4) Place Mat Tops total.

28. Layer and quilt as desired.
29. Sew the (8) $21 / 2$ " x WOF Fabric F strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Cut the binding into (4) equal lengths. Fold each strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
30. Bind as desired.
