













## Fabric and Supplies Needed

*Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.*

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## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

## Cutting Instructions

### **From Fabric A, fussy cut:**

one 23" x 40-1/2" center panel

### **From Fabric B, cut:**

four 1-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:

two 1-1/4" x 40-1/2" side Border 1 strips

two 1-1/4" x 24-1/2" top/bottom Border 1 strips

### **From Fabric C, cut:**

five 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

two 4-1/2" x 22" pieces for the side Border 2 units

two 4-1/2" x 12-1/2" pieces for the top/bottom Border 2 units

twenty 4-1/2" squares for Border 2

five 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 2-1/2" x 52" side Border 4 strips

two 2-1/2" x 38-1/2" top/bottom Border 4 strips

### **From each of Fabrics D, E and G-M, cut:**

two 3" circles using Template 1 or your preferred circle cutting method.

Note: These sizes reflect raw edge appliqué. If you choose to use needle turn, use Template 2 or cut a 3-1/2" circle.

### **From Fabric F, cut:**

six 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 5-1/2" x 56" side Border 5 strips

two 5-1/2" x 48-1/2" top/bottom Border 5 strips

From the remainder of the strip, cut two 3" circles using Template 1 or your preferred circle cutting method.

Note: These sizes reflect raw edge appliqué. If you choose to use needle turn, use Template 2 or cut a 3-1/2" circle.

### **From Fabric N, cut:**

six 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 1-1/2" x 50" side Border 3 strips

two 1-1/2" x 34-1/2" top/bottom Border 3 strips

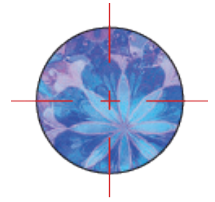
### **From the Binding Fabric, cut:**

six 2-1/2" x WOF strips



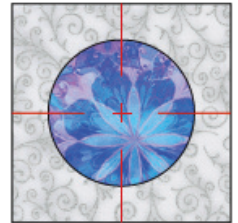
## Assemble the Applique Circle Units

**Step 1:** Fold and press each Fabric D-M circle in half along the length and width to press creases along the quarter.



**Step 2:** Repeat with all 4-1/2" Fabric C squares.

**Step 3:** Place one Fabric D circle right side up on a Fabric C square, aligning the creases in the circle with the seams in the square. Appliqué the circle to the square using your preferred raw edge appliqué method, such as a small zig zag stitch or blanket stitch.



*Note: Alternately, if using Template 2, use needle turn appliqué to stitch the circle to the unit, hiding the raw edges.*

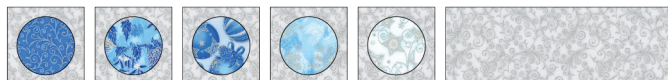
Repeat Step 3 for all Fabric D-M circles to create twenty Circle Units.



**Step 4:** Sew together Circle Units, in this order: Fabric I + Fabric J + Fabric K + Fabric L + Fabric M. Press. Sew the 4-1/2" x 22" Fabric C rectangle to the strip at the Fabric M end. Repeat to make a second unit like this. These are the side Border 2 units.



**Step 5:** Sew together Circle Units, in this order: Fabric D + Fabric E + Fabric F + Fabric G + Fabric H. Press. Sew the 4-1/2" x 12-1/2" Fabric C rectangle to the strip at the Fabric H end. Repeat to make a second unit like this. These are the top/bottom Border 2 units.





## Assemble the Quilt

**Step 6:** Sew the side Border 1 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 1 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

**Step 7:** Sew the side Border 2 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 2 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

**Step 8:** Sew the side Border 3 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 3 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

**Step 9:** Sew the side Border 4 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 4 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

**Step 10:** Sew the side Border 5 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 5 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

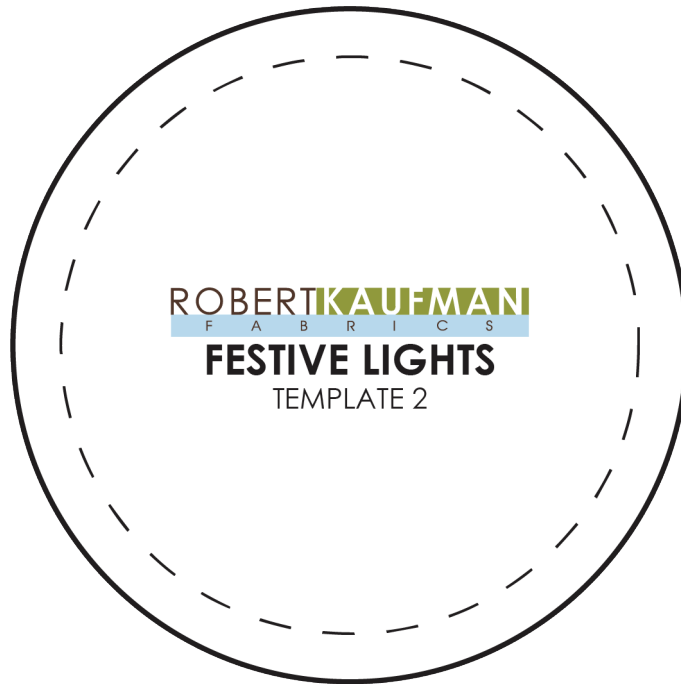


## Templates

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## Alternate Cutting for Holiday & Onyx Colorstories

*Cut Fabrics A-C, D, E, H-N and the binding as instructed for the Blue Colorstory.*

### **From Fabric F, cut:**

two 3" circles using Template 1 or your preferred circle cutting method.

Note: These sizes reflect raw edge appliqué. If you choose to use needle turn , use Template 2 or cut a 3-1/2" circle.

### **From Fabric G, cut:**

six 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 5-1/2" x 56" side Border 5 strips

two 5-1/2" x 48-1/2" top/bottom Border 5 strips

From the remainder of the strip, cut two 3" circles using Template 1 or your preferred circle cutting method.

Note: These sizes reflect raw edge appliqué. If you choose to use needle turn, use Template 2 or cut a 3-1/2" circle.
