The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 Halloween Whimsy Panel (PD11830)
2½ yards Border Stripe (CD11829)
11/8 yards Black Potion (C11827) includes binding
$3 / 8$ yard Orange Icons (C11823)
$1 / 4$ yard Green Stars (C11824)
$1 / 8$ yard Orange Potion (C11827)

## CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions before cutting fabrics. Refer to the quilt photo for the placement of fabrics. Label pieces as you cut. When fussy-cutting borders, remember $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowances are already included in the measurements.

## Halloween Whimsy Panel:

Centering the design, trim the panel to $35 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 431 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

## From Border Stripe fussy-cut:

2 Cream strips $8 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ LOF for Outer Border
2 Orange strips 63/4" $\times$ LOF for Outer Border
2 Green strips 53/4" $\times$ LOF for 2 nd Inner Border

## From Black Potion cut:

8 strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF for binding and set aside.
6 strips $214^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF for 3 rd Inner Border
2 strips $13 / 4{ }^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF; subcut:

From Orange Icons cut:
4 strips $214 " \times$ WOF for 1st Inner Border

## From Green Stars cut:

1 strip 63/4" $\times$ WOF; subcut:
4 rectangles $63 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## From Orange Potion cut:

1 strip $314^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF; subcut:
4 squares $31 / 4$ " A
1 strip $13 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ remaining strip length; subcut:
16 squares $13 / 4{ }^{\prime \prime} \quad B$

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to the cutting requirements list, quilt photo and layout diagram for the placement of prints and orientation of blocks. Follow the pressing arrows in the diagrams.

## Stitch 'N Flip (SNF)

The Stitch ' N Flip technique is used to add a triangle of a contrasting fabric to any corner, "replacing" a corner of the original shape. SNF is used to create the Slanted Star Corner Blocks in the 2nd Inner Border.

1. On the wrong side of 16 B squares, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner.
2. Position the drawn square right sides together onto 1 end of a $C$ rectangle oriented as shown. $B$ will replace the upper right-hand corner of C .
3. Stitch on the drawn line. Cut away excess fabric leaving $1 / 4$ " seam allowances. Flip the triangle up and press.
4. Repeat Steps 1-3 to make 8 CB units.

5. Repeat Steps 1-4. This time, use D and B, with B replacing the upper left-hand corner of D as shown. Make 8 DB units.


## Slanted Star Block Assembly

Collect the following pieces to assemble the Slanted Star Block:

1 A square
2 CB units
2 DB units
2 E squares

1. Sew DB units to opposite sides of an $A$ square as shown.
2. Sew an $E$ square to the $B$ side of a $C B$ unit. Repeat to make a second ECB unit.
3. Sew the ECB units to either side of the A square as shown. Make 4 Slanted Star Corner Blocks 533/4" square.

## Quilt Borders

Refer to the Quilt Layout Diagram and quilt photo for block and border orientation. Press seam allowances toward the borders.

## First Inner Border

1. Sew the 4 Orange Icons strips together in 1 long strip.
2. From the strip cut 2 borders $39^{\prime \prime}$ long and set aside.
3. From the strip cut 2 more borders $431 / 2$ " long and sew 1 to each side of the panel.
4. Sew a 39" border to the top, the other to the bottom of the panel. The quilt top measures 39 " $\times 47$ ".

## Second Inner Border

1. From each LOF Green Border strip cut a 47 " long and a 39" long border. Sew a 47" border to each side of the quilt.
2. Sew a Slanted Star Block to each end of both 39" border strips. Sew 1 to the top, the other to the bottom of the quilt. Be aware of the border and block orientation. The quilt top measures $491 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 57 \frac{1}{2}$ ".

## Third Inner Border

1. Sew the 6 Black Potion $2 \frac{1}{4}$ " strips together in 1 long strip.
2. From the strip cut 2 borders $571 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ long and sew 1 to each side of the quilt.
3. From the strip cut 2 more borders $53^{\prime \prime}$ long and sew 1 to the top, the other to the bottom of the quilt.
The quilt top measures $53^{\prime \prime} \times 61^{\prime \prime}$.

## Outer Border

1. Trim the 2 Cream Border strips to 61". Sew 1 to each side of the quilt.
2. Trim 2 Orange Border strips to 53 ". Sew an F rectangle to each end of both strips. Sew 1 border to the top, the other to the bottom of the quilt. The quilt top measures 69" $\times 73^{1 / 2}$ ".

## Finishing

Finish the quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with $21 / 2{ }^{2}$ Black Potion strips.
