	B Linen-esque 2929-43 <i>Green</i>	1-1/2 yds	(2) 2" x 42-1/2" WOF strips, piece as needed. (2) 2" x 26" WOF strips (5) 1-1/2" x WOF strips.* (7) 1-1/2" x WOF strips.* (7) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, BINDING.	
	C Pumpkin Farm Stripe 13045-99 <i>Multi</i>	1-2/3 yds	(2) 5" x 57" LOF strips. (2) 5" x 37" LOF strips.	
	D Scroll 5468-79 <i>Rust</i>	1/4 yd	(1) 5-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 5-1/2" squares.	
	E Outline Leaves 13052-07 <i>Natural</i>	3/8 yd	(2) 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 5-1/2" squares.	
	F Rustic Check 13053-44 <i>Green</i>	1/4 yd	(1) 5-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 5-1/2" squares.	
	G Rustic Autumn Sentiments 13050-71 <i>Natural/Multi</i>	3/8 yd	(2) 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 5-1/2" squares.	
	H Tossed Pumpkins 13051-79 <i>Rust</i>	1/4 yd	(1) 5-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 5-1/2" squares.	
	I Tossed Pumpkins 13051-44 <i>Green</i>	1/4 yd	(1) 5-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 5-1/2" squares.	
	J Rustic Autumn Sentiments 13050-79 <i>Rust</i>	1/4 yd	(1) 5-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 5-1/2" squares.	
	K Scroll 5468-44 <i>Green</i>	1/4 yd	(1) 5-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 5-1/2" squares.	
	L Sunflower Check 13046-79 <i>Rust</i>	1-3/8 yds	(7) 6-1/2" x WOF strips.	

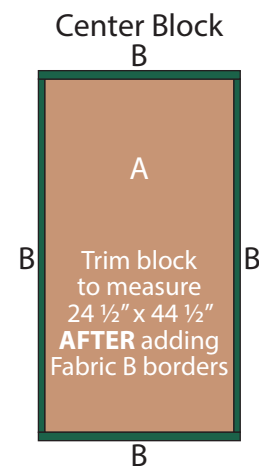
* SEW STRIPS VIA SHORT ENDS THEN GO TO BORDER ASSEMBLY
WOF/LOF=WIDTH/LENGTH OF FABRIC

BLOCK ASSEMBLY *PROJECT USES PRECISE 1/4" SEAMS. TEST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE BY CUTTING (2) 2-1/2" X 5" RECTANGLES. STITCH THEM TOGETHER ALONG THE 5" LENGTH. AT THE MIDPOINT, MEASURE ACROSS THE UNIT. IT SHOULD BE EXACTLY 4-1/2" WIDE. IF NOT, ADJUST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE AND REPEAT.*

Note: The arrows in the figures denote fabric direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

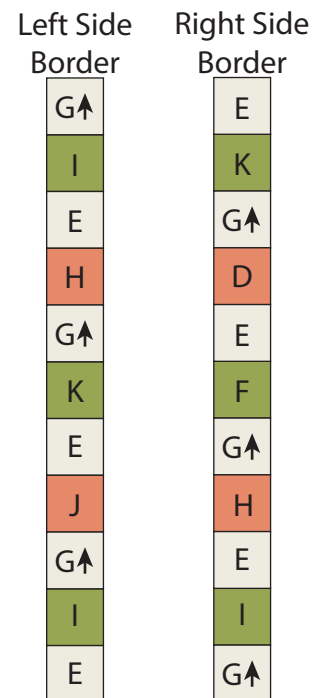
BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. Sew **B** 2" x 42-1/2" strip to each side of the **A** 23" x 42-1/2" rectangle. Sew (1) **B** 2" x 26" strip to the top and to the bottom of the **A** rectangle to make the **Center Block**. **Trim the block to measure 24-1/2" x 44-1/2"**.



2. Follow the diagram at right and sew together (11) assorted 5-1/2" squares to make the **Left Side Border**.

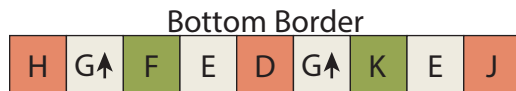
3. Follow the diagram at right and sew together (11) assorted 5-1/2" squares to make the **Right Side Border**.



4. Follow the diagram below and sew together (9) assorted 5-1/2" squares to make the **Top Border**.



5. Follow the diagram below and sew together (9) assorted 5-1/2" squares to make the **Bottom Border**.

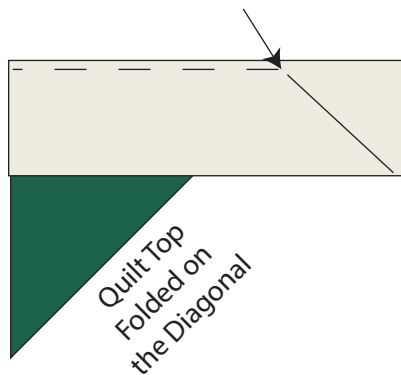


QUILT ASSEMBLY

6. Center (1) **C** 5" x 57" strip on (1) side of the **Center Block** and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a 1/4" from the top edge of the block and stop a 1/4" from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.

7. Repeat **Step 6** to sew (1) **C** 5" x 37" strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block**, making sure to stop and start 1/4" away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the **Center Block** on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides.

8. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in the diagram below), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a 1/4" seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners.



BORDER ASSEMBLY *MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE QUILT TOP TO ENSURE BORDER SIZES, BELOW ARE OUR CUTTING SIZES.*

9. Sew (1) **B** 1-1/2" x (53-1/2") strip to each side of the **Center Block**. Sew (1) **B** 1-1/2" x (35-1/2") strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block**.

10. Sew the **Left Side Border** and **Right Side Border** to the left and right sides of the **Center Block**.

11. Sew the **Top Border** and the **Bottom Border** to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block**.

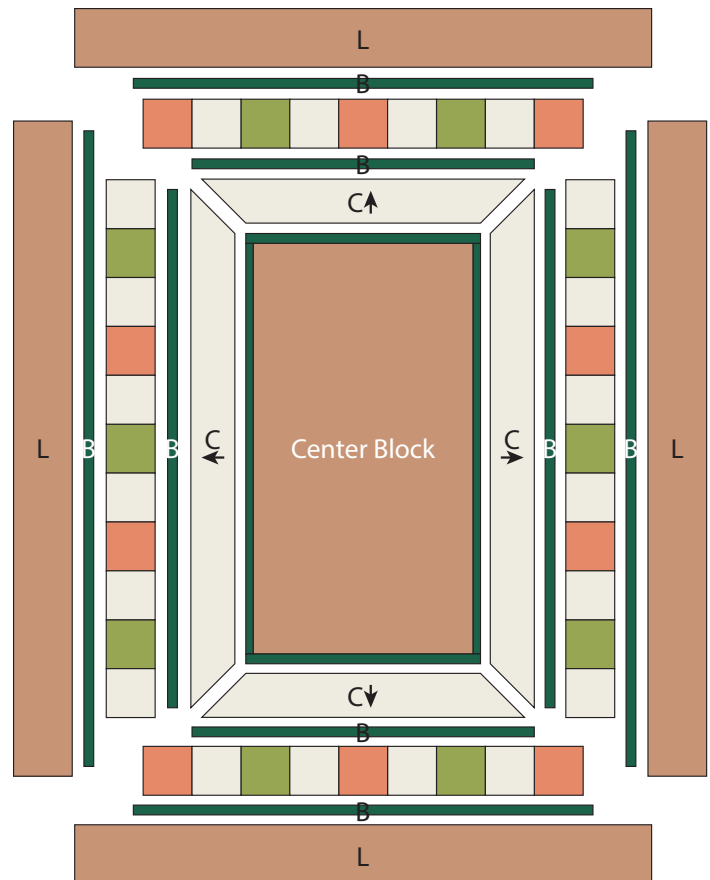
12. Sew (1) **B** 1-1/2" x (65-1/2") strip to each side of the **Center Block**. Sew (1) **B** 1-1/2" x (47-1/2") strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block**.

13. Sew (1) **L** 6-1/2" x (67-1/2") strip to each side of the **Center Block**. Sew (1) **L** 6-1/2" x (59-1/2") strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block** to make the quilt top.

FINISHING Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.
