(1) $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Subcut (3) 5-1/2" squares.
(1) $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Subcut (4) 5-1/2" squares.

2. Follow the diagram at right and sew together (11) assorted 5-1/2" squares to make the Left Side Border.
3. Follow the diagram at right and sew together (11) assorted 5-1/2" squares to make the Right Side Border.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY PROJECT USES PRECISE 1/4" SEAMS. TEST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE BY CUTTING (2) 2-1/2" X 5" RECTANGLES. STITCH THEM TOGETHER ALONG THE 5" LENGTH. AT THE MIDPOINT, MEASURE ACROSS THE UNIT. IT SHOULD BE EXACTLY 4-1/2" WIDE. IF NOT, ADJUST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE AND REPEAT.

Note: The arrows in the figures denote fabric direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

## Block Assembly

1. Sew B $2^{\prime \prime} \times 42-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to each side of the A $23^{\prime \prime} \times 42-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Sew (1) B 2" x 26 " strip to the top and to the bottom of the $\mathbf{A}$ rectangle to make the Center Block. Trim the block to measure 24-1/2" x 44-1/2".

2. Follow the diagram below and sew together (9) assorted $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares to make the Top Border.

5. Follow the diagram below and sew together (9) assorted 5-1/2" squares to make the Bottom Border.

## Quilt Assembly

6. Center (1) C 5" x 57 " strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a $1 / 4$ " from the top edge of the block and stop a $1 / 4$ " from the bottom edge. DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS. Repeat with the opposite side.
7. Repeat Step 6 to sew (1) C 5" x 37 " strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides.
8. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in the diagram below), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners.


BORDER ASSEMBLY MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE QUILT TOP TO ENSURE BORDER SIZES, BELOW ARE OUR CUTTING SIZES.
9. Sew (1) B $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} x\left(53-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) B 1-1/2" x (35-1/2") strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

## 10. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side <br> Border to the left and right sides of the Center Block.

11. Sew the Top Border and the Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
12. Sew (1) B $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} x\left(65-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) B 1-1/2" x (47-1/2") strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
13. Sew (1) $\mathbf{L} 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} x\left(67-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) L 6-1/2" x (59-1/2") strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

FINISHING Cut batting and backing 3 " larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.
