## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

WOF $=$ Width of fabric $\quad$＊Sew strips via short ends，then subcut as indicated in pattern

## BLOCK ASSEMBLY：Refer to BLOCK DIAGRAMS

1．Draw diagonal line on the wrong side of $\mathbf{L} 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares．

2．Place（1） $\mathbf{L} 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square right sides together on top right corner of A 6－1／2＂square．Sew on drawn line，then trim excess to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ and press open．Repeat bottom left corner to complete BLOCK 1A．Square to 6－1／2＂，make（2）．

3．Repeat step 2 using $\mathbf{B}, \mathbf{C}, \mathbf{D}, \mathbf{E}, \mathbf{G}$ ，and $\mathbf{H}$ squares to create remaining blocks．Square to 6－1／2＂．Make（2）each．

QUILT ASSEMBLY：Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM for proper placement
BLOCK DIAGRAMS
 and rotation．

4．Sew（1） $\mathbf{M} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to each side of $K 23-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42-$ $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle．

5．Sew BLOCKS together as shown to create SIDE UNITS，then sew to sides of quilt．

BORDER ASSEMBLY：Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes．Below are our measurements．Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM for proper placement and rotation．

6．Sew（1） $\mathbf{M} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} X\left(42-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side of quilt，then sew（1） $\mathbf{M} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} X\left(39-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to top and bottom of quilt．
7．Sew（1）$J 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} X\left(44-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side of quilt，then sew（1）$J 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} X\left(43-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to top and bottom of quilt．
8．Sew（1）F $4^{\prime \prime} X\left(48-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side of quilt，then sew（1）F $4^{\prime \prime} X\left(50-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to top and bottom of quilt．

FINISHING:
Cut batting and backing 3 " larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with L fabric.
