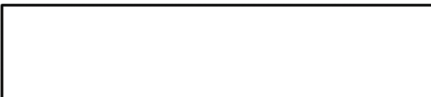

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

### From the Fur-Ever Friends 36in Panel (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 32  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 40  $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle centered on four panels.

### From the Solid White (B), cut:

- (2) 2" x 40  $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x 35  $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.
- (3) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 46  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (2) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 40  $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.
- (3) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 52  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (3) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 46  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

### From the Morning Glory (C), cut:

- (3) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (2) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 38  $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.

### From the Butterflies and Bubbles (D), cut:

- (3) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 48  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (3) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 44  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (3) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 60  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (3) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 54  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (7) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding.

### From the Playful Pups (E), cut:

- (2) 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 54  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- (3) 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 52  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

### From the Doggone Cute (F), cut:

- (4) 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 62  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (3) 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 60  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

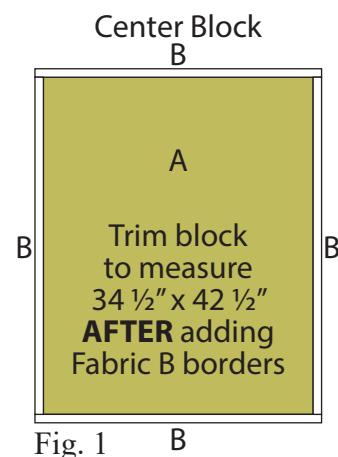
### From the Doggone Cute (Backing), cut:

- (2) 68" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 68" x 76" back.

## Block Assembly

**Note:** The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

- Sew (1) 2" x 40  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 32  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 40  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x 35  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure 34  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42  $\frac{1}{2}$ ".**



## Quilt Top Assembly

**(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)**

- Sew (1) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 38  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to the top and bottom of the Center Block.
- Sew (1) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 46  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 40  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of the Center Block.
- Sew (1) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 48  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 44  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to the top and bottom of the Center Block.
- Sew (1) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 52  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 46  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of the Center Block.



6. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 54 ½" Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 52 ½" Fabric E strip to the top and bottom of the Center Block.

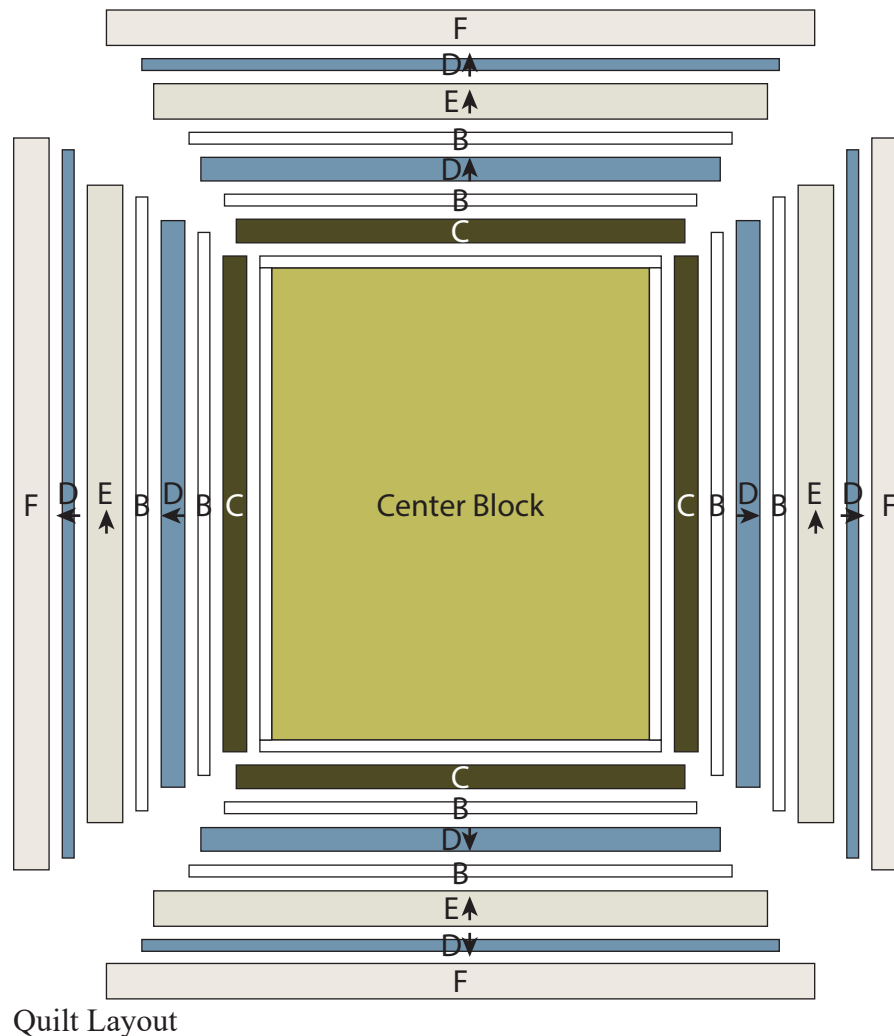
7. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 60 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 54 ½" Fabric D strip to the top and bottom of the Center Block.

8. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 62 ½" Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 60 ½" Fabric F strip to the top and bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

9. Layer and quilt as desired.

10. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric D strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

11. Bind as desired.



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
