$1 / 4$ yard Tossed Motorcycle - Gray (E) 513-90
$1 / 4$ yard Motor Plate - Black (F) 515-99
$1 / 2$ yard Modern Melody Basics - Pigment White (G)

$3 / 8$ yard $\quad$ Brick - Brick $(\mathrm{H}) \quad$ 516-88
$7 / 8$ yard Patchwork - Black (I) 518-99
$31 / 4$ yards Tonal Print - Gray (Backing) 514-90

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

## From the 24 Inch Bike Panel - Brick (A):

-(1) $42 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 221 / 2 \prime$ rectangle, centered on the panel.
From the Gravel Texture - Charcoal (B), cut:

- (2) 2 " $\times 221 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
- (3) $2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $2 " \times 451 / 2 "$ strips.
-(6) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Tossed Tools - Charcoal (C), cut:
-(1) $41 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $41 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ strips.
From the Sign Tossed - Stone (D), cut:
-(1) $41 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $41 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Tossed Motorcycle - Gray (E), cut:
-(1) $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $41 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ strips.
From the Motor Plate - Black (F), cut:
-(1) $41 / 2 \prime$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $41 / 2 \prime$ squares.
From the Modern Melody Basics - Pigment White (G), cut:
- (2) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) 2 " $\times 361 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
- (3) $2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $2 " \times 471 / 2 "$ strips.


## From the Brick - Brick (H), cut:

- (3) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $31 / 2 " \times 471 / 2 "$ strips.


## From the Patchwork - Black (I), cut:

- (3) $81 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $8 \frac{1}{2 \prime} \times 471 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Tonal Print - Gray (Backing), cut:
-(2) 55 " x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the $55 " \times 69 "$ back.

## Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ "seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) $2 " \times 221 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the 42 $1 / 2 " x 221 / 2 "$ Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x $45 \frac{1}{2} \gg$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure $441 / 2 " \times 241 / 2$ ".

2. Sew (1) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to the top of (1) $41 / 2 "$ Fabric D square lengthwise to make (1) Unit 1 rectangle (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (3) Unit 1 rectangles total.

3. Repeat Step 2 and refer to Figures 3-5 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (2) Unit 2 rectangles, (3) Unit 3 rectangles and (2) Unit 4 rectangles.


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4. Sew together (1) $41 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ Fabric C rectangle,
(1) Unit 1 rectangle, (1) $41 / 2 " \times 6 \frac{1}{2} "$ Fabric E rectangle,
(1) Unit 2 rectangle, $41 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ Fabric C rectangle,
(1) Unit 1 rectangle, $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E rectangle,
(1) Unit 2 rectangle, $41 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ Fabric C rectangle,
(1) Unit 1 rectangle and $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6 \frac{1}{2} "$ Fabric E rectangle, in that order from left to right, to make the Top Border (Fig. 6).

5. Repeat Step 4 and refer to Figure 7 for component identification, placement and orientation to make the Bottom Border.

## Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 6. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
7. Sew (1) 2" $\times 361 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x $471 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
8. Sew (1) $31 / 2$ ’ $47 \frac{1 / 2 "}{}$ Fabric $H$ strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
9. Sew (1) $81 / 2 " \times 471 / 2 "$ Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
10. Layer and quilt as desired.
11. Sew the (6) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
12. Bind as desired.
