## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the 24 Inch Panel - Brick (A):

- Fussy cut (1) $221 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ rectangle, centered on the panel

From the Gravel Texture - Charcoal (B), cut:

- (2) 2 " $\times 42 \frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips, piece as needed.
- (2) $2 " \times 251 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
- (3) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $11 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ x $10 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ strips.

From the Tossed Motorcycle - Gray (C), cut:

- (3) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $31 / 2 " \times 441 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) $31 / 2 " \times 301 / 2 "$ WOF strips.

From the Sign Tossed - Stone (D), cut:
-(2) $81 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (6) $81 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Tossed Tools - Charcoal (E), cut:
-(4) $51 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $51 / 2 " \times 731 / 2 "$ strips.
-(4) $51 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $51 / 2 " \times 631 / 2 "$ strips.

- (2) $51 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $51 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Brick - Brick (F), cut:
-(8) $3 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (56) $3 " \times 51 / 2 "$ strips.
From the Tonal Print - Gray (G), cut:

- (8) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (112) 3" squares.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Crimson Red (H), cut:
-(3) $33 / 8 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (28) $33 / 8 "$ squares.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Black (I), cut:

- (3) $33 / 8$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (28) $33 / 8 "$ squares.
- (4) 2 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " x $701 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) 2 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " x $531 / 2 "$ strips.
- (8) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the binding.

From the Motor Plate - Black (J), cut:
-(1) $51 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $51 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Patchwork - Black (Backing), cut:

- (2) $91 "$ x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the $71 " \times 91 "$ back.


## Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) $2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the $221 / 2 " \times 421 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) $2 " \times 251 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure $241 / 2 "$ x $441 / 2 "$.
2. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 8 \frac{1}{2} / 2$ Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $81 / 2$ " Fabric D square. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}>\times 10 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric D square to make (1) $101 / 2$ " Block One square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (6) Block One squares total.

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3. Place (1) 3 " Fabric G square on the left side of (1) $3 " \times 51 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip, right sides together (Fig. 3). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance (Fig. 4).

4. Place another 3" Fabric G square on the right side of the 3 " $\times 51 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip, right sides together (Fig. 5). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 5). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 6).
5. Repeat Steps 3-4 to make (56) Unit 1 strips total.

6. Place (1) $33 / 8 "$ Fabric H square on top of (1) $33 / 8$ " Fabric I square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 7). Sew $1 / 4 "$ away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 7). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 8) to make (2) halfsquare triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 3 " to make (2) Unit 2 squares (Fig. 9). Repeat to make (56) Unit 2 squares total.

7. Sew (1) Unit 2 square to each end of (1) Unit 1 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to each side of (1) $51 / 2 "$ Fabric E square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) $101 / 2 "$ Block Two square (Fig. 10). Repeat to make (8) Block Two squares total.
8. Sew (1) Unit 2 square to each end of (1) Unit 1 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to each side of (1) $51 / 2$ " Fabric J square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) $101 / 2$ " Block Three square (Fig. 11). Repeat to make (6) Block Three squares total.

9. Sew together (1) Block Three square, (1) Block Two square, (1) Block One square, (1) Block Two square, and (1) Block Three square, in that order from top to bottom, to make (1) Side Border (Fig. 12). Repeat to make a second Side Border.
10. Sew together (1) Block One square, (1) Block Two square, (1) Block Three square, (1) Block Two square and (1) Block One square, in that order from left to right, to make the Top Border (Fig. 13). Repeat to make the Bottom Border.

Quilt Top Assembly (Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 11. Sew (1) $31 / 2$ " $\times 441 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $31 / 2 " \times 301 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
12. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block.
13. Sew the Top Border and the Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
14. Sew (1) $2 " \times 701 / 2 "$ Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x $531 / 2 "$ Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
15. Sew (1) $51 / 2 " \times 731 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $51 / 2 " \times 631 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
16. Layer and quilt as desired.
17. Sew the (8) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric I strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
18. Bind as desired.


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
