

Sub cut each of the fabrics into 8-4.5" squares.

1. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner of Fabric $A$ on the WRONG SIDE. This line will be the cut line. **Kim likes to use fabric tape that can be purchased a Sew Storm Quilt Shop. Additionally, you can draw a "SEW" line a 1/4" from the cut line to stitch down.
2. Place Fabric A and Fabric B right sides together. Sew a 1/4" from the cut line on each side.
3. Use a rotary cutter and ruler to cut directly on your "cut" line. You will have 16 half square triangles.
4. Press seams open. Trim each block to 4".
5. Arrange the half square triangles according the the diagram above.
6. With right sides together, sew squares together using a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam.
7. Sew rows together to finished the pieced star block.
