## Wall Hanging Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Strawberry Panel 24" x 44" - Multi (A):
-(1) $221 / 2 " \times 281 / 2 "$ rectangle centered on the panel
From the Diagonal Plaid - Multi (B), cut:

- (2) 2 " $\times 28^{1 / 2}$ " WOF strips.
- (2) 2 " $\times 251 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
- (2) $11 / 2 " \times 381 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
-(2) $11 / 2 " \times 341 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
From the Strawberry Lattice - Multi (C), cut:
-(2) $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 301 / 2$ " WOF strips.
-(2) $41 / 2 " \times 241 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
From the Packed Strawberries - Red (D), cut:
-(1) $41 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $41 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Small Tossed Strawberries - Multi (E), cut:
- (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Crimson Red (F), cut:

- (4) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.

From the Large Strawberry Vine - Multi (Backing), cut: -(1) 48 " $\times 42$ " WOF strip for the backing

Wall Hanging Block Assembly
Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) $2 " \times 281 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the $221 / 2 " \times 28^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) $2 " \times 251 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure $24 \frac{1}{2 \prime} \times 301 / 2 "$.

2. Place (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric E square on the top left corner of (1) $41 / 2 "$ Fabric D square, right sides together (Fig. 2). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 2). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $1 / 4$ " away from the sewn seam (Fig. 3).

3. Follow Figure 4 for the seam direction to add a $21 / 2$ " Fabric E square to each of the remaining corners of the $41 / 2$ " Fabric D square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 5).
4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make (4) Unit 1 squares total.

## Wall Hanging Assembly

 (Follow the Wall Hanging Layout in Figure 6 while assembling the wall hanging top.)5. Sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 301 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block.
6. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to each end of (1) $41 / 2 " \times 241 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the newly sewn strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
7. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 38^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 341 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the Wall Hanging top.
8. Layer and quilt as desired.
9. Sew the (4) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric F strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
10. Bind as desired.

## Place Mat Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Strawberry Garden - Multi (A), cut:

- (1) $61 / 2 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $61 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Spring Green (B), cut:

- (1) $41 / 4 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $41 / 4 "$ squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (32) $41 / 4$ " triangles.
- (2) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) $31 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Packed Strawberries - Red (C), cut:

- (1) $41 / 4 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $41 / 4 "$ squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (32) $41 / 4 "$ triangles.


## From the Small Tossed Vine - Multi (D), cut:

- (1) $37 / 8 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $37 / 8 "$ squares.
- (2) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) $31 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Tossed Strawberry Flower - Blue (E), cut:

- (1) $37 / 8 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $37 / 8 "$ squares.
- (1) 2 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 " squares.

From the Tossed Strawberry Flower - Red (F), cut:

- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2" squares.

From the Folio - Powder Blue (G), cut:

- (1) $41 / 4 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $41 / 4 "$ squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (32) $41 / 4 "$ triangles.


## From the Border Stripe - Multi (H), cut:

- (1) $121 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $121 / 2 " \times 5 "$ strips.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Crimson Red (I), cut: - (7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.

From the Tossed Strawberry Sprigs - Multi (Backing), cut:

- (2) 16 " $\times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 16 " $\times 21$ " rectangles for the backings.

Place Mat Block Assembly
Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.
11. Place (1) $3^{1 / 2 \prime}$ Fabric B square on the top left corner of (1) $61 / 2 "$ Fabric A square, right sides together (Fig. 7). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 7). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $1 / 4$ " away from the sewn seam (Fig. 8).

12. Follow Figure 9 for the seam direction to add a $31 / 2$ " Fabric B square to each of the remaining corners of the $61 / 2$ " Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 10).
13. Repeat Steps 11-12 to make (4) Unit 2 squares total.

14. Place (1) 2" Fabric F square on the top left corner of (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric D square, right sides together (Fig. 11). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 11). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle z away from the sewn seam (Fig. 12).

15. Follow Figure 13 for the seam direction to add a $2 "$ Fabric E square to the lower right corner of the $31 / 2 "$ Fabric D square to make (1) Unit 3 square (Fig. 14).
16. Repeat Steps 14-15 to make (16) Unit 3 squares total.

17. Place (1) $37 / 8$ " Fabric D square on top of (1) $37 / 8$ "

Fabric E square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 15). Sew $1 / 4$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 15). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 16) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure $31 / 2 "$ square to make (2) Unit 4 squares (Fig. 17). Repeat to make (16) Unit 4 squares total.

18. Paying attention to the fabric direction, sew (1) Fabric C triangle to the Fabric D side of (1) Unit 4 square. Sew (1) Fabric G triangle to the Fabric E side of the Unit 4 square to make (1) Unit 5 piece (Fig. 18). Repeat to make (4) Unit 5 pieces total.

19. Sew (1) Fabric B triangle and (1) Fabric G triangle together along short sides. Sew the newly sewn triangle to the left side of (1) Unit 5 piece. Paying attention to the fabric direction, sew (1) Fabric C triangle and (1) Fabric B triangle together along short sides. Sew the newly sewn triangle to the right side of the Unit 5 piece to make (1) $31 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ Unit 6 rectangle (Fig. 19). Repeat to make (4) Unit 6 rectangles total.

20. Repeat Step 19 and refer to Figures 20-22 for fabric identification, placement and ORIENTATION to make (4) of each unit rectangle for Unit 7 through Unit 9 .

21. Sew (1) Unit 3 square to each end of (1) Unit 6 rectangle to make the top row (Fig. 23).
22. Sew together (1) Unit 7 rectangle, (1) Unit 2 square and (1) Unit 8 rectangle, in that order from left to right, to make the middle row (Fig. 23).
23. Sew (1) Unit 3 square to each end of (1) Unit 9 rectangle to make the bottom row (Fig. 23).
24. Sew together the (3) rows from Steps 21-23 lengthwise to make the $121 / 2$ " Block One square (Fig. 23).
25. Repeat Steps 21-24 to make (4) Block One squares total.

Place Mat Assembly
(Follow the Place Mat Layout in Figure 24 while assembling the wall hanging top.)
26. Sew (1) $5 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 121 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip to the left side of (1) Block One square to make (1) Place Mat top. Repeat to make (4) Place Mat tops total.
27. Layer and quilt as desired.
28. Sew the (7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric I strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press. Cut the strip into (4) equal pieces.
29. Bind as desired.
