WOF $=$ Width of fabric *Sew strips via short ends, then subcut as indicated in pattern

## BLOCK ASSEMBLY: Refer to BLOCK DIAGRAMS

BLOCK DIAGRAMS

BLOCK 1

1. As shown in diagrams, sew 4 " squares together into pairs, then sew pairs together to create BLOCKS. Square all to $7-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, make (3) of each block.

QUILT ASSEMBLY: Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM for proper placement and rotation.
2. Sew (1) $\mathbf{J} \mathbf{2}^{\prime \prime} \times \mathbf{4 2 - 1 / 2 "}$ strip to each side of $\mathbf{A} 23-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} X$ 42-1/2" rectangle.
3. Sew BLOCKS together as shown to create SIDE UNITS, then sew to sides of quilt.
4. Sew (1) $\boldsymbol{J} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 40-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to top and bottom of quilt.
5. Sew (1) D 8-1/2" $\times 40-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to top and bottom of quilt.

BORDER ASSEMBLY: Measure width and length of quilt top to ensure border cutting sizes. Below are our measurements. Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM for proper placement and rotation.
6. Sew (1) J $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} X\left(61-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side of quilt, then sew (1) $J 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} X\left(42-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to top and bottom of quilt.
7. Sew (1) M $4^{\prime \prime} X\left(63-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to each side of quilt, then sew (1) M $4^{\prime \prime} X\left(49-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strip to top and bottom of quilt.

## FINISHING:

Cut batting and backing $3^{\prime \prime}$ larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with K fabric.
