*During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows, 66 runs online (20%), 264 runs paper (80% each day. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease, or increase either one accordingly.*

### CONFIRMATIONS & JUDGING PROGRAMS

An email confirmation will be sent at the time of processing if a legible, valid email address is provided on the entry form. Additional confirmations will be emailed to acknowledge move-ups and corrections/changes prior to closing. A final confirmation and judging program will be emailed after the trial closes. Printed confirmations and judging programs will be mailed to exhibitors without email addresses after the trial closes. PLEASE CHECK YOUR CONFIRMATION! OWNERS/HANDLERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR REVIEWING ALL INFORMATION IN THE CONFIRMATION LETTER EACH TIME IT IS SENT AND CONTACTING THE TRIAL SECRETARY IMMEDIATELY IN WRITING (EMAIL) IF A CORRECTION/CHANGE NEEDS TO BE MADE.

Any exhibitor who does not receive a preliminary confirmation within 10 days of mailing a paper entry should contact the Trial Secretary to confirm receipt of paper entry.

Any exhibitor who does not receive the judging program within 7 days prior to the trial should contact the Trial Secretary.

### AWARDS

A qualifying score is required for all awards. Placement ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th place in each height division of each class at each trial. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. New title ribbons will be awarded to teams earning a new title. Clean Run ribbons will be available for Novice and Open runs only. *A commemorative MACH/PACH ribbon and MACH/PACH bar will be awarded to each dog earning a MACH, or PACH title at these trials.*

**SPECIAL TRIPLE "Q" PRIZE:** Every dog/handler team earning a Qualifying Score in a Standard class, a JWW class, and either T2B or FAST (all Regular or all Preferred) in a single trial will receive a gift certificate not to exceed \$25.00. Prize must be claimed on the day of the trial.

### NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

**Declination of entries:** The Hutchinson Kennel Club Inc. may decline entries for cause and may refuse to receive or remove any dog on account of aggression, disease, deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No one shall have any claim or recourse against the Hutchinson Kennel Club, Inc. or any official thereof.

**Refund Policy**

Entry fees will be refunded if an entry is pulled before the closing date and time

Refund checks must be cashed within 90 days or check can be canceled

No refunds will be made for any entry pulled after the closing date except as stated in the Wait List policy

**Bitches in Season** are not permitted in the Trial. The HKC will refund full refunds less \$10.00 per day for bitches unable to compete for that reason. **Dogs injured and unable to compete** will be refunded all but \$10.00 per day with verification from your veterinarian. The Trial Secretary must be informed of such claims for refund 1/2 hour before the start time each day.

**Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent,** disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee or other acts beyond the control of the Trial Committee it is impossible to open or to complete the event, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$30.00 service charge for any returned checks.

**No Refund for Duplicate Entries.** We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

**Owners are Responsible for Errors on Entry Forms,** whoever may have made such errors. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors, nor will cancellation of entries be allowed after the published closing date.

**A Wait List will be created** to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 30 entries will be placed on this wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to the closing date. Any entries withdrawn by 6:00 pm October 27, 2022, will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a waitlisted entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any waitlisted entry that does not move off the waitlist into the trial will receive a full refund.

**Exhibitors must be governed by any rules** or regulations or civil authorities, building and parking restrictions. Vehicles parked contrary to regulations will be subject to towing at the owner's expense.

**The safety of the dogs is our primary concern.** By entering this trial, exhibitors are acknowledging that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform the obstacles safely.

**All dogs must be on leash** at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such a case, no refund of any fees paid will be made

**No flash photography** will be allowed while a dog is running on the course.

**Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s).** Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available.

**Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate** when it is their turn to run.



**CLASS CHANGES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2020**

**Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day**

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. For example, the same dog may now be entered in Regular FAST and/or T2B to finish up those titles while also entered in Preferred Master STD/JWW to start working towards their PACH at the lower height. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed.

Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

**Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)**

FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the **Time 2 Beat and FAST classes**. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring
  - Toys must be non-audible
  - Toys may not leave the handler's hand
  - Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

**Fix and Go On (FnG)**

FnG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle and then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note.

Using FnG will result in a non-qualifying score.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or *back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine Partners Program**<sup>SM</sup> may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

**Junior Handlers** should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
