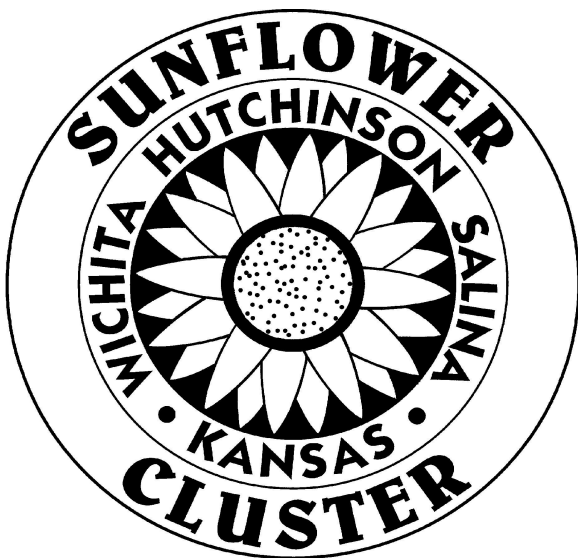

# Rosetta Pearl Bartels

January 12, 1940 — June 20, 2025



Rosetta Pearl Bartels, 85, passed away Friday, June 20, 2025, at Mennonite Friendship Communities, South Hutchinson. She was born January 12, 1940, in Enid, Oklahoma, the daughter of Ralph and Anola Heusel Skinner. She lived on the Heusel homestead farm near Salt Fork River in Grant County until she was 7 years old. The farm was claimed by John Heusel, her grandfather, when the Cherokee Strip was opened for homesteading.

She moved to Blackwell, OK during her first-grade year and attended an elementary school about four blocks from her home on Blackwell Ave. She was there through her third-grade year. The family then moved to the Dry Ridge farm near Uniontown during the summer of 1949 in Bourbon County, Kansas. She attended Dry Ridge Grade School, a one room school for fourth and fifth grades. She would ride her horse to school every day. That then consolidated with two other grade schools to form Lime Ridges for sixth, seventh, and eighth grades. She graduated from grade school

in April 1954. She then attended Uniontown Rural high school and graduated in May of 1958. She started college at Kansas State College in the fall of 1958 and graduated in May of 1962 with her bachelor's degree in Home Economics Education.

She started teaching vocational home economics in Inman, Kansas in the fall of 1962 and continued teaching through the spring of 1967. She married Robert Bartels on June 20, 1965, in Inman. They had two daughters, Rosetta Diane, born June 12, 1969, and Laura Clare, born October 25, 1980. Robert passed away on November 15, 2010.

While married, Rosetta helped found the Inman Museum, worked at the Inman Library, where she was on the library board and was an integral part of getting it moved to its current location. She was a member of the Hutchinson Kennel Club for over 20 years, the La Leche League for 50 years, and a member of St. Peter's United Church of Christ.

She is survived by her two daughters, Laura Stevenson, Inman and Diane Bartels, Hutchinson and 4 grandchildren, Drake, Tristan, Honoria, and Gideon Stevenson. She was preceded in death by her parents and her husband.

All dogs that are owner-handled and are not exhibited in the National Owner-Handled Series by professional handlers\* meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward’s book & the catalog. **Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers, household members and current assistants to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition during the entire show. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend. However, current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.**

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are competing in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

The breed will not be represented in the Owner-Handled Group if there is no eligible dog competing in the Best of Breed, or in Best of Winners competition.

*\*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers’ organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.*

**NOVICE SENIOR CLASS** - For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards★, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN JUNIOR CLASS** - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards★ in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

**OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS** - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards★ in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

**OPEN SENIOR CLASS** - For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards★ in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

**MASTER CLASS** - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show and who have won ten (10) Best Junior Handler awards with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

The Pee Wee Special Attraction is a pre-Junior Showmanship class. The Pee Wee class is geared toward children 5 years to under 9 years of age.

Each Pee Wee unit consists of the child, his/her parent, guardian, or responsible adult, and the dog.

Only one Pee Wee unit is in the ring at a time. This is not a competitive class, but rather a fun, learning experience for the child and the adult. • A dog must be at least four months of age to enter the Pee Wee class.

Bitches in season will not be allowed to participate.

- All dogs entered must have the proper lead and collar.
- A responsible adult must be present with the child both inside and outside the ring. The adult is to maintain control of the dog outside of the ring.
- Dogs must be AKC Registered Purebred dogs.
- At the time of entry, a release must be signed by the child's parent or legal guardian.

The safety of both the dogs and Pee Wee inside and outside the ring is a primary concern.. An additional lead, provided by the Club, will be at the Judge's table. At the Judge's discretion and for safety - based upon the size of the child and the dog, the adult may be asked to attach a second lead to the dog allowing both child and adult to walk the dog together.

Although the word "judge" will be used, this is designed to be a learning and mentoring experience. No Pee Wee will be "judged" but rather will be mentored with the age appropriate amount of information to help prepare them for what they will be expected to know about AKC regular Junior Showmanship once they reach 9 years of age. The children will be mentored, one child, their adult, and dog while in the ring.

Neither the youngster nor the adult should be asked to show a dog's bite.

Each child will receive a Dog Related Item (Minimum Value \$5.00) to commemorate the experience. Also, the child minus their dogs need to show up at the conclusion of the class to have a group picture taken with the judge.

### **Section 1 - Classifications**

- The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for puppies that are over four months of age but under six months on the day of the event.
- Classes are offered for breeds and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3 Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show
- The FSS competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show

### **Section 2 - Entry and Eligibility**

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- Puppies must have one of the following:
  - An Individual registration number registered with the American Kennel Club (AKC)
  - A Foundation Stock Service (FSS) registration number
  - A foreign born dog may enter if they are registered in the country of origin, as defined in Chapter 11, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Professional handlers, members of their household and current assistants to professional handlers may personally exhibit in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition. Entries must be marked "Exhibition Only" prior to the close of entries.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by the forenamed may compete for awards in this competition but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.
- Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month Beginner Puppy Competition.

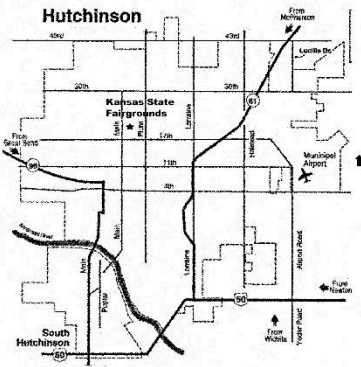

## AKC® Code of Sportsmanship and Civility

Preface: The tradition of competitive purebred dog events predates 1884—the year the American Kennel Club (AKC®) was founded. Those involved in these sports share core values, including a strong commitment to sportsmanship and a welcoming, respectful culture that embraces the diverse community united by a love of dogs.

These values are evident across all aspects of the sport: conformation, performance, companion, and family dog activities. Many believe that the enduring principles of sportsmanship and civility are key reasons the sport has thrived for over 140 years.

Recognizing that periodically reaffirming our shared values strengthens our community, the revised code will be shared widely to highlight the foundational values and principles that define the sport.

- Sportspeople always place the welfare of their dog above all else.
- Sportspeople prioritize the long-term health and preservation of their breed, making decisions that reflect a deep commitment to responsible breeding and ownership.
- Sportspeople respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportspeople conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively on the sport, the American Kennel Club, and themselves.
- Sportspeople appreciate, encourage and support all who associate with and participate in the sports by fostering an environment where respect, equity, inclusion, and courtesy are foundational.
- Sportspeople understand, uphold and abide by all AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies.
- Sportspeople contribute to a positive atmosphere at events by avoiding negative gossip, disparagement, or unsportsmanlike behavior.
- Sportspeople extend their values of civility, fairness, and respect to all digital and social media platforms.
- Sportspeople actively support the education and mentorship of newcomers, helping them learn the rules, values, and traditions of the sport in a respectful way.
- Sportspeople recognize that they are role models in the sport, and strive to lead by example through humility, kindness, and ethical conduct.
- Sportspeople treat fellow exhibitors, judges, officials, volunteers, spectators, and AKC staff with dignity and respect, regardless of experience, background, or differences in opinion.
- Sportspeople are committed to fair play, honesty, courtesy, and competition, approaching both winning and losing with grace.
- Sportspeople understand that strong competition and civility can—and should—coexist. They appreciate the quality of their competitors, and the effort put forth by others.
- Sportspeople uphold their responsibilities to the sport of purebred dogs and refuse to let personal gain or self-interest influence their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsperson judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsperson judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsperson exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsperson exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- Sportspeople are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportspeople decline to exploit any positions of authority or recognition for personal advantage.
- Sportspeople appreciate those that have gone before them and realize they are responsible for maintaining and enhancing the sport for future generations.
