

### Adding Borders

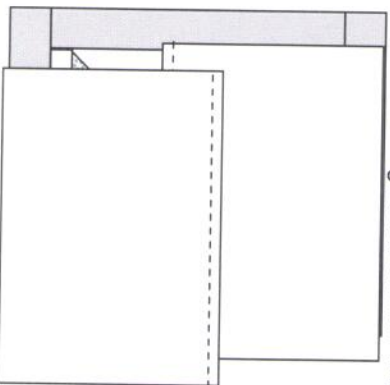
Cut border strips at 2 1/2".  
Add borders to all four sides.  
Top unfinished size 16 1/2" x 18 1/2"

### Making a Pillow

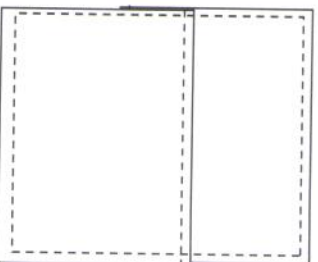
Cut two backing pieces 16 1/2" x 12".

Hem one edge along the 16 1/2" length on both pieces.

Layer the ribbon top right side up, then hemmed back right side down, then second back right side down. The back will overlap in the center.



Align all edges and stitch 1/4" seam around entire. (shown below offset to see the overlap)



Turn right side out. Add pre-form pillow.

A pillow with recognition, support, comfort, healing and LOVE.

Ribbon ~ one 2 1/2" strip x WOF  
Background ~ Fat Quarter  
Border ~ two 2 1/2" strips x WOF  
Pillow Back ~ 1/2 yard  
Brilliant Bindings tool



# Brilliant Ribbon Pillows

## Cutting

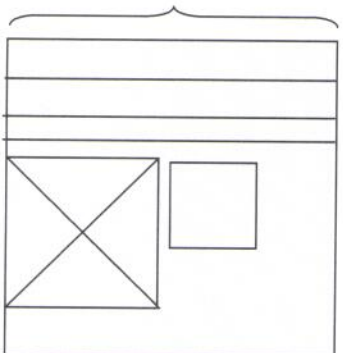
### Background ~ Fat Quarter

Cut 2 strips at 2 1/2" across FQ

1 ~ 2 1/2" x 14"

1 ~ 2 1/2" x 14" with 45° end

use **Brilliant Bindings** to cut 45° angle



1 ~ 2 1/2" x short BB tool (see cutting description in Main Print)

Cut 1 strip at 1 1/2"

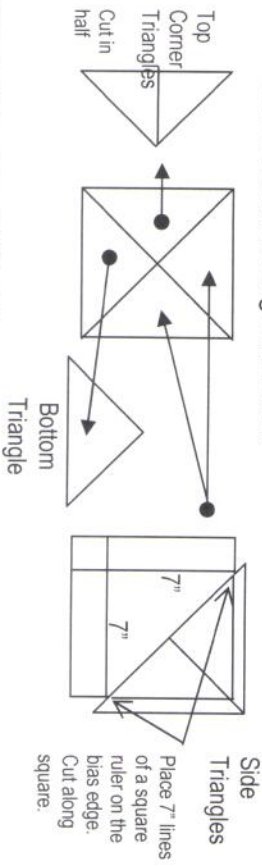
1 ~ 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" (top)

Cut 1 square at 4 1/8" (center)

Cut 1 square at 8 7/8", cut diagonally twice

sub cut as shown in diagrams below

## Main Print ~ One 2 1/2" strip

2 ~ 2 1/2" x 10 1/2"

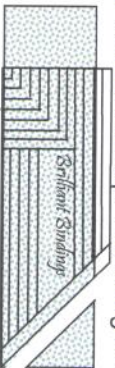
from each 10 1/2" rectangle sub cut into 2 short BB tools (USE 2" square line, shown in red for the short BB shape). Total of 4 short BB tool shapes.

By placing the BB tool on the fabric as shown and making the cut along the 45° edge you are also cutting the second BB shape from this rectangle.



1 ~ 2 1/2" x 14"

Place the BB tool at one end with BB face up. Cut along the 45° edge to create the long ribbon tail.



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## Layout and Sewing Order

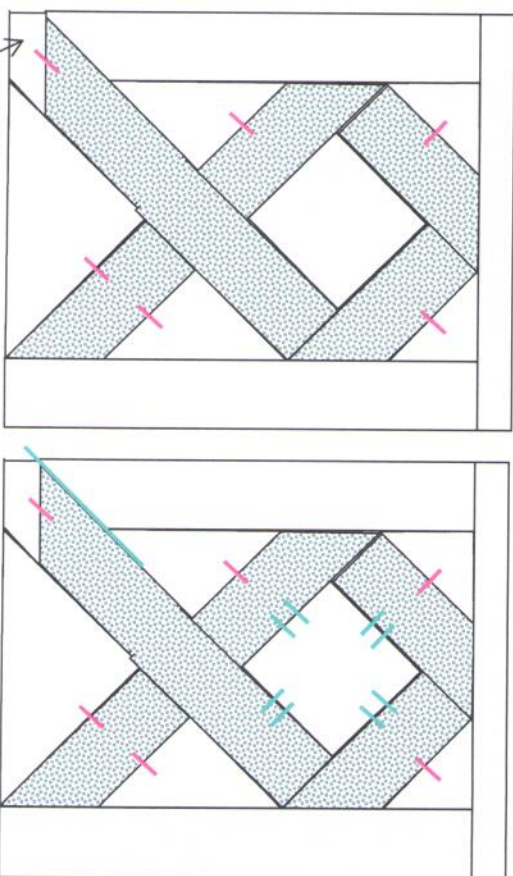
### Arrange pieces

Begin by sewing all #1s together (single pink slash markers).

Press toward the ribbon fabric. **WAIT to trim.** Replace into position.

Add center square. This is a partial seam construction! (double teal lines)

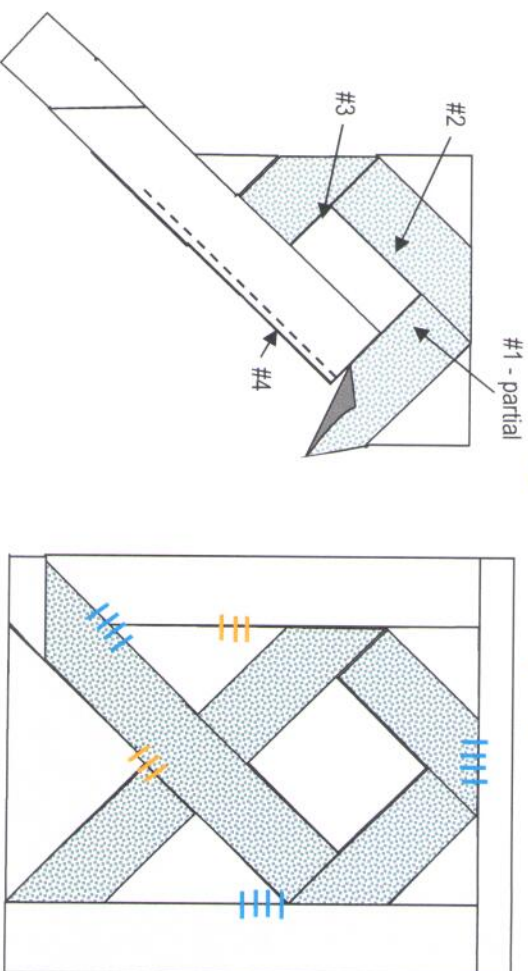
Leave the long BB seam open from point shown with teal line.



Short BB tool  
Shown already trimmed

Partial seam order of construction shown below on the left.  
Trim top corners.

Continue sewing with triple orange seams, then quadruple blue seams.
