

Flip Flops

Supplies

Blue stripe fabric 7"x8"

Gold fabric 3"x5"

Cream 5"x6"

Red (yo-yos) 3"x6"

30 mm yo-yo maker (optional)

2 star buttons (optional)

Heat n Bond Lite or other fusible web material

Dark Brown thread for appliqué stitch

Red tea towel or 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " or 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square cream Fabric for quilt block



<u>Directions:</u> Following the instructions provided by the fusible web manufacturer, trace 1 set of the Flip Flop pieces grouping together pieces that will be using the same fabric. Cut pieces out. Follow the pattern placement sheet, place on tea towel or quilt square. Iron in place. Using a blanket, zig zag or satin stitch on your sewing machine; sew along the edges of all the pieces. Practice on some scrap material if you are new to machine appliqué. If you prefer hand stitching you can do a blanket stitch using 2 strands of DMC floss. Embellish your flip flops with star buttons and yo-yos. Enjoy!
